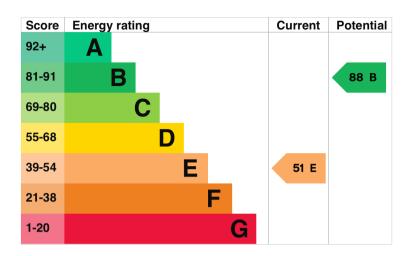


OVERALL FLOOR AREA 60 square metres APPROX

Entering the cottage, you feel as if you are being greeted by an old friend. The thick walls radiate with the love and care of eight decades of family ownership, creating a home that is full of character.

The whitewashed walls of the bright living room frame a charming fireplace that houses a woodburning stove, the perfect focal point on a chilly Cornish night. It is easy to imagine days spent relaxing in front of the fire, or curled up on the charming window seat, watching the world go by. A separate dining room provides a cosy space for family meals, and benefits from another woodburning stove and a window onto the rear courtyard.

Passing the shower room and WC, you find the cottage kitchen, which is flooded with light from a large, central Velux window. This space has been thoughtfully refurbished and has a rear door that leads to your outside space. Stone steps lead from the back door to the sunny, elevated courtyard, a perfect place for dining or entertaining. Characterful stone walls enclose this pleasant area, creating a sheltered and private retreat.

Back inside, follow the stairs to the first floor, where you find two attractive bedrooms, both decorated using a coastal colour palette very fitting with the history of the cottage. A large double room sits to the front of the home, where light pours in through two shuttered windows, both with wide window seats enjoying a glorious rooftop view to the church. The second room is a cosy twin, with double aspect windows and a bright and cheerful feel.

Single glazed window to the rear elevation, fireplace with inset log burner, ceiling light, stairs to first floor, under stairs storage, beams to ceiling, electric radiator, open doorway to:

#### INNER HALL

Storage cupboards, skylight, door to side giving access to small yard area, step up with doors to WC and shower room, open doorway to:

# **KITCHEN**

Velux window, stable door to rear, strip light, electric radiator, base and wall units incorporating stainless steel sink unit, spaces for under counter fridge; oven; dishwasher and washing machine.

#### SHOWER ROOM

Tiled shower enclosure with electric shower, fitted wash hand basin, wall light, extractor fan.

#### CLOAKROOM

Wall light, extractor fan, low level WC.

Steps up from the kitchen lead to a raised courtyard area with balustrade and walled boundaries, with planters and external lighting.

Freehold tenure. Council tax band B. Mains electricity, water and drainage. Electric heating plus log burner. Fibre broadband, full mobile signal available. No parking included. 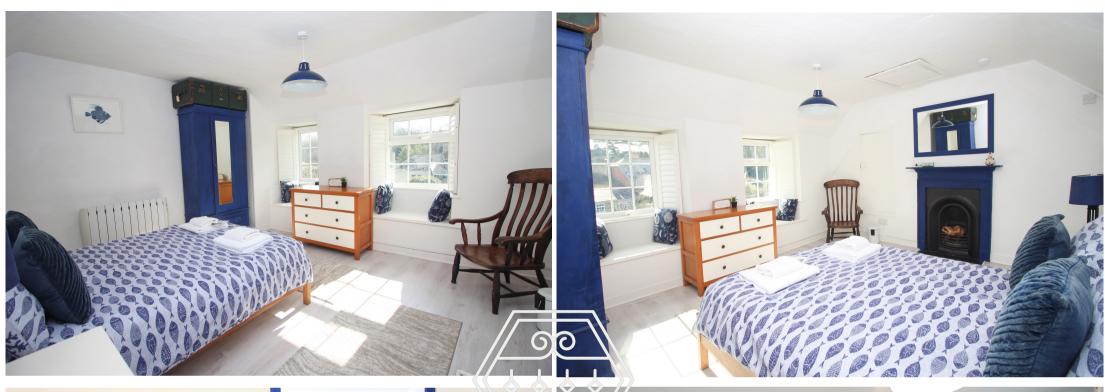
