Location

Set some five miles southeast of the city centre, Craigmillar promises a fantastic setting for young families and professionals keen to escape the hustle and bustle of the capital, without leaving the city limits. The area is a short distance to the Royal Infirmary and Edinburgh University and schooling in the area is wellrepresented right through from nursery to senior level. Residents are just five minutes' drive from Fort Kinnaird Retail Park and ten minutes' drive from an ASDA superstore, so have no shortage of retail and leisure facilities at their disposal. Sport and fitness enthusiasts can choose from a gym, fitness classes and court/pitch hire at Jack Kane Sports Centre or luxury facilities at Bannatyne Health Club & Spa in neighbouring Newcraighall. The area is served by fast and frequent bus links into Edinburgh City Centre and across East Lothian, terminating in Haddington. Newcraighall station also operates regular rail services between Edinburgh and Tweedbank along the Borders Railway Line. For travel further afield, proximity to the A1 and Edinburgh City Bypass guarantees swift links to the M8/M9 motorway network and Edinburgh International Airport.

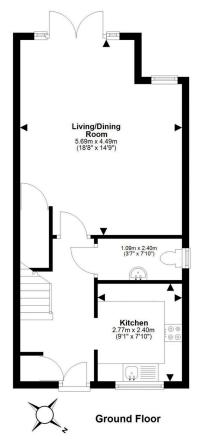

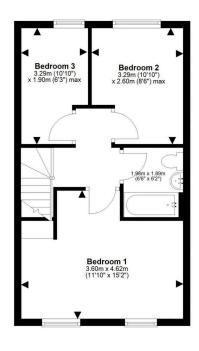












First Floor
