DESCRIPTION

Unit 6b comprises a semi detached industrial/warehouse unit with loading canopy. The unit is of steel portal frame construction with part brick, part profile metal sheet elevations under an asbestos cement sheet roof with intermittent roof lights. There is access directly to the warehouse via a loading door beneath the canopy or a separate pedestrian door on the front elevation. Internally the unit has a small GF office, canteen/kitchen, male and female WC's and a corridor leading to warehouse area. The FF is fitted out as offices.

LOCATION

The unit is on the established Herald Industrial Estate on Herald Road off Botley Road in Hedge End. The immediate area is characterised by a mixture of industrial, trade counter and retail warehouse occupiers, including the likes of Halfords, Tile Flair, ScrewFix and Howdens. Access to J7 of the M27 is via Botley Road and Charles Watts Way (A344).


