


Welcome to Park Place



Hampton Wick station is just a three-minute walk away from the development with services into London Waterloo within 33 minutes.

Amenities

Kingston Town Centre is just a short 15-minute picturesque stroll over the river where you will find an array of boutique and high street brands including a large Marks & Spencer on the pedestrianised main shopping street with a John Lewis and Waitrose, a lively market with a variety of independent vendors and the Bentall Centre which is home to over 75 shops and more than 1000 stylish brands.

Kingston has a lively and varied offering featuring everything from the latest theatre productions to performances by up-and-coming comedians. There are two theatres in Kingston. The Rose Theatre and the Arthur Cotterell Theatres, both offering a selection of classic and modern productions. The Rotunda (open 7 days a week) is located 16 minutes from Park Place and is home to a collection of bars and restaurants, an impressive 14 screen Odeon cinema and tenpin which houses a bowling alley, pool tables and an amusement arcade.

David Lloyd Leisure can also be found in the Rotunda offering its members cutting edge-gym equipment, personal trainers, a pool, wet spa and fitness classes.


Schools




