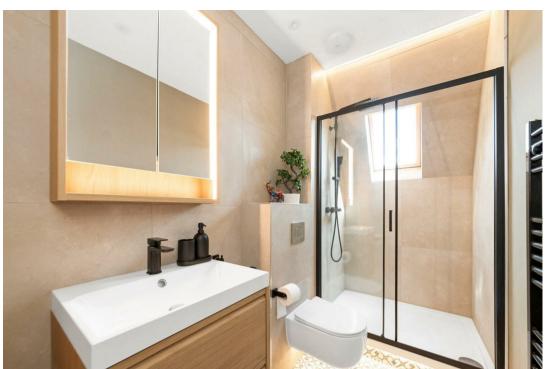

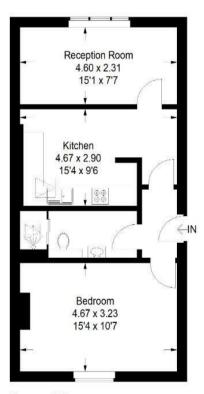


Floorplan

Auckland Road, SE19

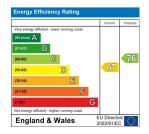
