## Overview

With far-reaching views over countryside to the North Devon coast around Bideford Bay.

A gently sloping paddock conveniently located to the north eastern edge of the popular village of Braunton just 3 miles from the are sand dunes and beach at Saunton.

Braunton Down, as the name implies, was a large open area of internally unfenced farmland divided into a number of individually owned sections and devoted primarily to arable farming.

The land lies around the 400 foot contour and has outstanding views over unspoiled farmlands to the north towards Boode, westwards to Saunton Down and to the south-west to Clovelly and Hartland point overlooking Bideford Bay and the sand dunes at Saunton

Today the land is all in one ownership and the current owner is releasing some small sections of land to the market.

This particular section, just over one and a half acres, was planted with a wide variety of trees in 2021 which varieties include chestnut, ash, oak, rowan, holly and alder and other broadleaved trees some 10 or 12 varieties . There is no income to be derived but an obligation to continue with the trees until 2024/5
