A charming 17th century cottage located in the delightful semi-costal village of Fremington, Barnstaple. Being a grade II listed building, it highlights history and charm that is hard to find elsewhere.

Within a short stroll you have a range of restaurants, take aways, pubs, church, shops and beautiful walks that lead to the North Devon Tarka Trail. There is also a frequent bus route that provides great access to Barnstaple, Bideford, Instow and other close by costal villages.

The lovely garden adds to the appeal of this house, providing a perfect spot for relaxing or entertaining guests on a sunny day. It has been beautifully maintained by the current owners and there are several areas to sit out and enjoy some alfresco dining.

This property is bursting with character features and inside you will notice the original timber beams and beautiful wood panelling and natural stone which surrounds the fireplace. The wood burner creates a lovely focal point to the room and an ideal spot for an afternoon siesta. A separate dining room is perfect for more formal dining and hosting friends and family.

The kitchen, which is located to the rear of the property and has a view of the garden makes for an ideal spot for keeping an eye on your toddlers along with a range of built in storage cupboards and plenty of preparation space to inspire the joy of home cooking. Although the kitchen has been updated it suits the property and the upgrades have been made with detail and attentiveness.

Also on the ground floor there is a further reception room currently used as a salon but could also be used as a study perfect for those looking to work from home. There is plenty of storage in the property with a range of cupboards and a ground floor WC and shower room.

Whilst upstairs there are four spacious bedrooms, all of which have been tastefully updated by the current owners and now providing plenty of space for the family. The bedrooms are all good proportions, whilst bedroom number four is currently used as a study, but also could have its uses for a craft/hobbies room.

The property has been brought back to life with a combination of exposing its character and modern additions like panelling and acute paintwork. The family bathroom is a good size with stand alone modern roll top bath and modernised fittings throughout.
