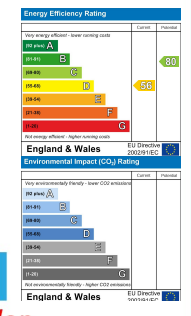

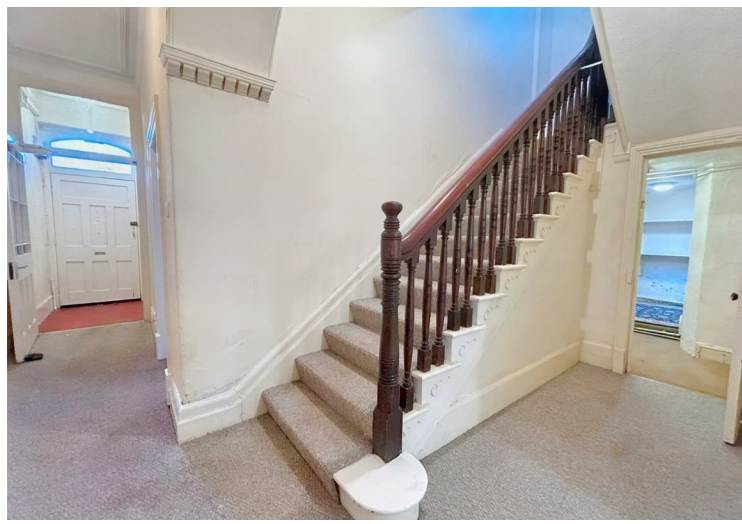

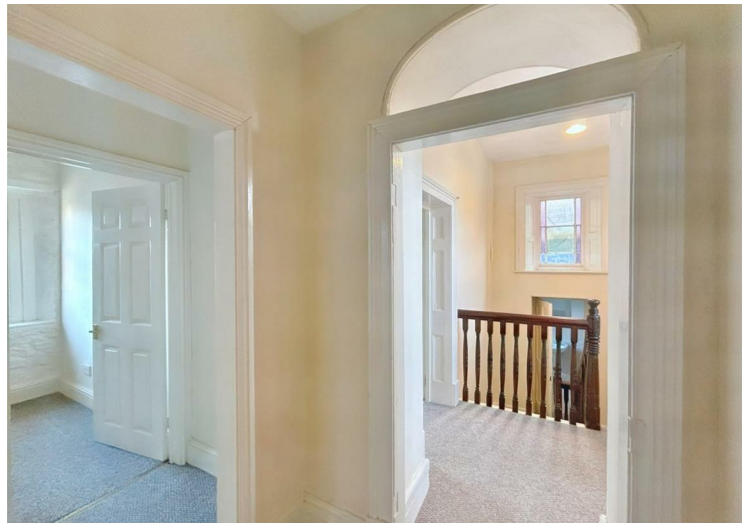

Taskers Old School House is a well-presented townhouse located in an elevated position with views over the county town of Haverfordwest. The property dates back to the early 1900's and maintains many of its original and character features.

The property briefly comprises of hallway, lounge, kitchen / diner, utility, cloakroom, boiler room on the ground floor. Upstairs are a family bathroom, four bedrooms and a separate shower.

Externally the property benefits from a low maintenance courtyard, off road parking as well as a garage to the rear. The property is on mains services and benefits from gas central heating.

The market town of Haverfordwest has numerous facilities and amenities on offer, which include a good range of shops, retail parks, primary and secondary schools, sixth form college, hospital, mainline train station, new leisure centre/swimming pool, cinema, restaurants and pubs.
