DIRECTIONS

At our office turn right at Station Road traffic lights, follow the road keeping in the left-hand lane. At the next set of traffic lights carry straight on taking the first turning on your right signposted "New Road". Continue on this road and at the mini-roundabout take the first turning off, follow the road going straight through the next set of traffic lights and carry on traveling along the road going through the little hamlet of "Pen Y Mynydd" making your way into "Trimsaran". At the mini roundabout take the first turning off signposted "Carway". Follow "Culla Road" taking the second turning on you left signposted for "Pontnewydd". Follow the road taking a left-hand bend and continue to follow going past a few properties on your right.
