

EVERYTHING ON YOUR DOORSTEP


The charming village of Binfield has a doctor's surgery, a dentist, a chemist and a post office within the Co-op store. There is also a coffee shop, a fish & chip shop and other takeaway restaurants, as well as three popular pubs.

One of which is the 14th century Stag and Hounds, a former hunting lodge steeped in history. With its low beams, comfortable sofas and huge open fireplaces, The Stag and Hounds is the ideal spot for a traditional Sunday lunch.

In addition to the new school adjacent to The Fairways, Binfield has a village Primary School with day nursery, four parks, a cricket club and a well supported football club, with teams for all ages.

Just two miles away*, the town of Bracknell is a bustling centre for employment – with many national companies having their HQ there, including Waitrose, Honda and Fujitsu. Bracknell has excellent shopping, both in the town centre and in the modern Lexicon shopping centre, where you'll find Fenwick, M&S, H&M and dozens of other big names, including Waitrose and Sainsbury's. There's a 12 screen cinema and places to eat from pizzas to burgers, Italian to Japanese.

SO MUCH TO SEE AND DO

Around The Fairways there are dozens of places to visit and things to do for the whole family. Dinton Pastures Country Park for those partial to water sports and Bracknell Forest is great for walking and cycling. The John Nike Leisure sport Centre in Bracknell has the longest artificial slope in the south east, as well as tobogganing and ice skating. Windsor Great Park and Legoland are within 10 miles*.

Other great days out include Gravity Force in Camberley, an amazing indoor trampoline park with a host of different fun games to try, and Longridge Activity Centre, with Dragon Boating, Jacobs Ladder, Crate Stacking, Giant Swing and much more. For a more sedate outing, you can't beat a boat trip on the Thames, or simply lazing by the river at Henley on Thames, just 13 miles away*.











EDUCATION FOR ALL

At the centre of The Fairways development is the brand new King's Academy School, an 'all-through' school, welcoming children from nursery age through to sixth form.

The secondary school officially opened in September 2018 with the primary school being opened a year later in September 2019. The King's Academy Binfield boasts state-of-the-art facilities, an integrated SEND provision and on-site sports and community facilities.

With a core belief that 'every single student deserves an outstanding education', King's Academy Binfield offers a completely unique opportunity to families with children.







PERFECTLY PLACED

The Fairways is right at the hub of the hi-tech employment hot-spot along the M4 corridor, so commuters are in the perfect location.

The M4 (Junction 10) is just 1.7 miles away*, putting Wokingham (3.6 miles and 11 mins by car*) Reading (11 miles, 20 mins*) and Central London (35 miles, around an hour*) all within easy reach.

By train from Bracknell station, (2 miles*), regular direct services run to Reading (19 mins*) and London Waterloo (1hr 5 mins*), with new Crossrail services due to start soon. The nearest airport is Heathrow which is only 25 miles away*, while Gatwick is 47 miles away.*
