


And this place is the tenth smallest country in the world: Montenegro.

Montenegro's spectacular Luštica Peninsula — the largest of its kind in all Montenegro — sits between Boka Bay and the Adriatic Sea.

And nestled in this idyllic stretch of land is Luštica Bay: a cosmopolitan and vibrant destination in which to live, dine, shop and sail.

With its beautiful, secluded surroundings, it feels like a remote hidden gem. Yet Luštica Bay is positioned deceptively near to Tivat International Airport and offers fantastic travel connections to popular destinations in the rest of Montenegro: from the neighbouring Boka Bay and beyond.

THE VISION.

Luštica Bay is already a flourishing community, a place where locals have long savoured the natural beauty of the peninsula. And now the bay is set to become a 690 hectare resort — roughly double the size of New York's Central Park, and four times bigger than Monaco — which blends seamlessly with its surroundings. Only 10% of the land will be built up, creating a town that embraces the charm and feel of the Montenegrin traditional village, powered by future-forward vision.

If a lively waterfront Riviera lifestyle is what you crave then Marina Village hosts a wealth of attractions with the marina itself at its heart. All set within the captivating architectural grace of a traditional Montenegrin fishing village.

As part of the wider masterplan for Luštica Bay the town of Centrale has been designed to offer all the conveniences you would expect in a modern town: a buzzing piazza, verdant parks, restaurants, a school, a bank, medical care and emergency services, sports facilities, wellness treatment centres and destination shopping. A place where everyone can feel at home with luxurious facilities around every corner.

Montenegro's own Plantaže Winery offers red, white, rosé and sparkling wines to delight the palate of connoisseurs and enthusiasts alike.

And all of this wonderful scenery serves as the fitting backdrop to a truly world-class golf course.





The Peak's 18-hole golf course — Montenegro's first — presents players of all levels with a fresh challenge and awe-inspiring views.



STUNNING VIEWS IN EVERY DIRECTION, FROM THE TEE TO THE SEA.



With a creative vision anchored on the local vernacular, translating the traditional materials and building techniques of Montenegro into pared down, contemporary forms, they have recognised local heritage with modern design. Homes formed with natural materials at their core, including stone and wood, to create secluded, private gateways. 
