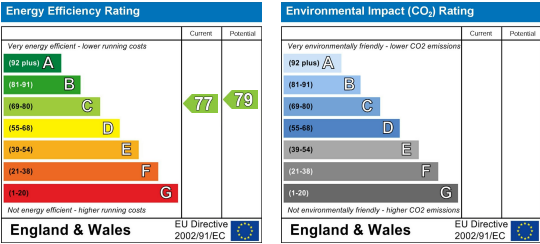


Floor Plan
