Welcome to Valley Fields Farm, a truly exceptional and rarely available detached farmhouse, set within approximately 10.5 acres of permanent pastureland with extensive farm buildings. This highly attractive property, cherished by the same family for over 40 years, offers a wonderful blend of traditional charm, generous living spaces and immense future potential.

Occupying a prominent yet private position on the tranquil edge of Upper Fulbrook hamlet, Valley Fields Farm benefits from the peace of rural life while being just a short, distance from the historic and vibrant towns of Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwick and Leamington Spa.

The area has a rich cultural heritage and features a variety of English Heritage and National Trust properties and gardens, castles at Warwick and Kenilworth and the Royal Shakespeare Theatre.

The house is within the catchment for a variety of excellent grammar and private schools.

The farmhouse: A home with heart and potential

Built in the 1950s, this four-double-bedroom traditional farmhouse is presented in good condition throughout, offering a warm and inviting atmosphere from the moment you step inside. The well-proportioned living accommodation is designed for comfortable family life:

- > **Ground floor**: There is a large, inviting open-plan kitchen and dining area, perfect for family gatherings and modern living. A separate formal dining room provides an elegant space for entertaining, complemented by a generous sitting room ideal for relaxation. There is also a utility room, two separate WCs and wood burners in both the sitting room and dining room. The rooms at the back of the house open onto an outside undercover veranda from which you can enjoy the beautiful views over the garden and the land beyond..
- > First floor: Four spacious double bedrooms with the master having an en-suite. There is also a family bathroom. All the upstairs rooms have outstanding views across the gardens and surrounding countryside.
- > Outside: The house is surrounded by mature gardens, with the rear garden backing directly onto the surrounding pastureland, creating a delightful connection between the home and its rural setting. There are mature fruit trees within the gardens. A good-sized driveway leads to a spacious two-storey double garage with workshop, affording ample parking.

While beautifully maintained, Valley Fields Farm presents a blank canvas for its next owners. It offers clear potential for modernisation, reconfiguration, or extension (subject to necessary planning consents). This makes it an ideal opportunity for buyers looking for a substantial family home with significant scope to personalise, add value, and create their dream lifestyle.

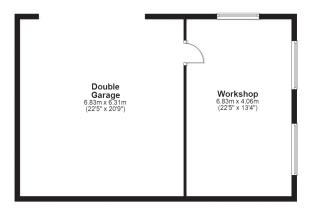

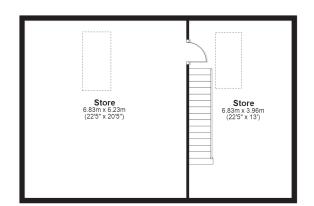




First Floor Approx. 145.7 sq. metres (1568.8 sq. feet)
