Step inside to discover Acorn Cottage. Curl up in front of the log burner in the snug, perfect for those cosy winter evenings. The sitting room offers a slightly more formal reception room with French doors that open fully into the Orangery.

There are two additional bedrooms, each with delightful outlooks and built-in wardrobe storage. 












Glorious Gardens...


Out and about...

Nearby Manley village is a quiet, quaint English village. The village hall has a full calendar of events to get involved with if you want a sense of community. There is a local community shop in nearby Ashton, a church, and a local train station with access to Manchester and Chester and country walks in all directions. 
"Delamere Forest is so close and is lovely for an autumnal walk."
