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Location

The public house is located in a residential street in the village of South Darenth, some 4.5 miles to the south of Dartford town centre.

South Darenth is part of the parish of Horton Kirby with a population of 3,500 in total. A former Mill located close-by has been converted to over 200 dwellings and also houses four businesses including a Co-op store. The village is located within open country side and close to other villages such as Farningham, Eynsford and Sutton at Hone.

Excellent transport links in the area, Farningham Road railway station is under a mile distant, with trains to London Victoria taking 38 minutes. Ebbsfleet International station is within seven minutes' drive of South Darenth.

The M25/A2 junction is approximately two miles distant and Bluewater shopping centre is approx. 4 miles.
