Kilmichael House is one of the oldest houses on the Island of Arran, and is listed for its architectural and historic significance.

It is at the centre of an ancient estate, owned by the same family for hundreds of years: from the beginning of the 14th century through to 1950. With a 17th century core and subsequent enhancements in the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries, the property is described in the title deeds as "the mansion house", but it is actually of a more manageable size than that description suggests.

Set in up to three acres of mature, landscaped grounds, with woodland, an arboretum and a garden sanctuary, it it much more than just another "house for sale".

Gardens

They feature a variety of woodland, beautifully manicured lawns, flower gardens, decoratively paved walkways as well as being home to resident peacocks - in the past these stunning gardens have even been used for glamorous fashion shoots.

Kilmichael House is located on the outskirts of Brodick village, and is the feature property within this exclusive residential settlement.

Brodick village's amenities include a bank, shops, hotels, restaurants and bars, excellent leisure facilities at Auchrannie Resort and the all weather pitches at the Ormidale Park as well as an 18-hole golf course. The village boast a vibrant community and well used village hall, as well as a primary school with early years classes and the High School with the UHI Argyll hub is in Lamlash which pupils travel to daily.

The Isle of Arran is a beautiful and accessible island, a place where you can find a little bit of everything you could ever want from a Scottish island; an ever-changing coastline, dramatic mountain peaks, sheltered beaches, verdant forests, great cultural festivals and a wealth of tasty local produce. It is an hour on the ferry from the Ayrshire coast and less that two hours from Glasgow.

Services

Kilmichael House is connected to mains electricity and water; drainage is to a SEPA registered shared septic tank on the grounds. Hot water and heating are via an oil fired boiler supplying radiators throughout. The property is responsible for a two ninth share of the maintenance costs for the access road, which is approximately £400 per annum.

Council Tax

Council Tax charges are set out by North Ayrshire Council, and the property is banded G.

Floor plan is not to scale and is to be used for guidance only. Room sizes are approximate.

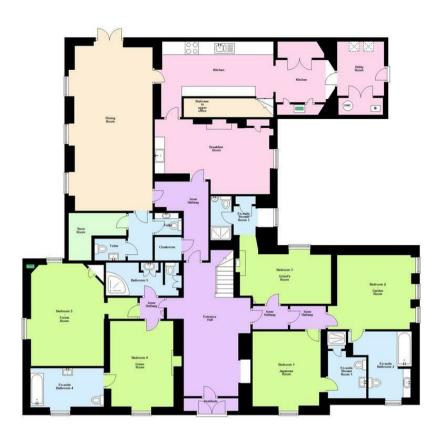
Viewings by appointment

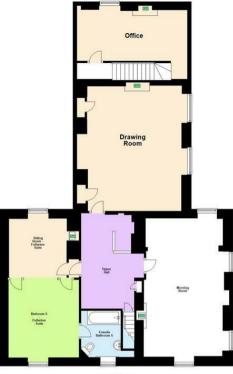

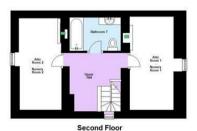






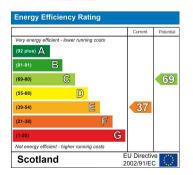


First Floor

DIRECTIONS

From Brodick pier turn right and pass through the centre of the village. Access to the Kilmichael estate is by the public road leaving from the village, at the corner by Brodick Golf Clubhouse and leading up Knowe Road on the left. Proceed along the Knowe Road for half a mile to the gates of Kilmichael House. Continue through the gates for approximately 200m where Kilmichael House is on the right hand side.
