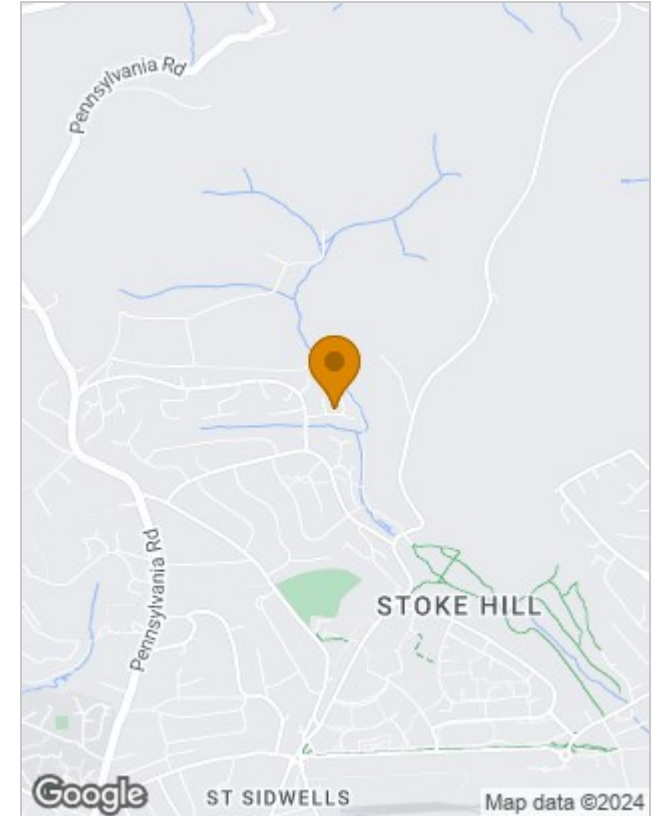




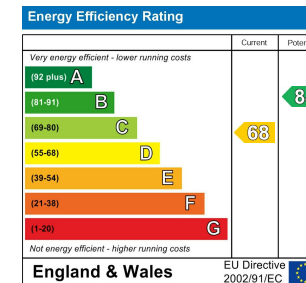
Floor Plans
