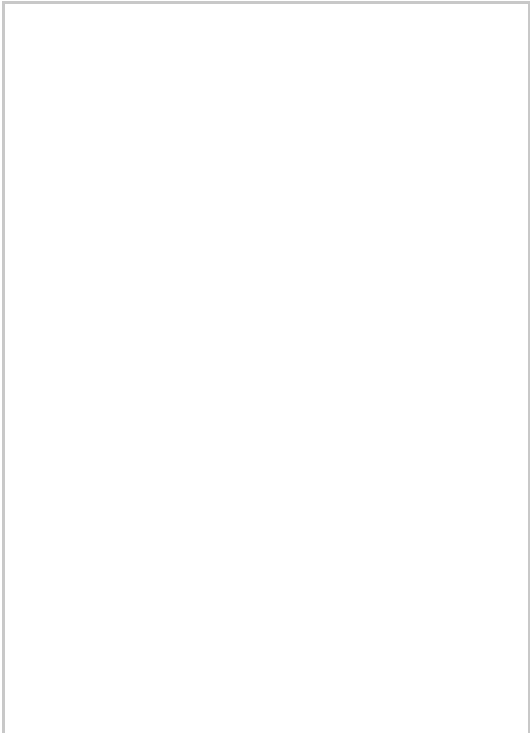
To the first floor are 3 good sized bedrooms and the upgraded family bathroom. Bedroom 3 currently being used as an office/dressing room with fitted wardrobes.

Externally to the rear is a south facing garden, laid to lawn with access to the garage space. The 2 car drive completes this impressive home.

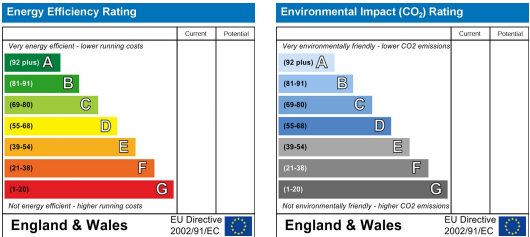
Area Map
