This charming 1930s hillside home has been carefully updated and extended in line with modern family requirements. The entrance hall with traditional spindled staircase and oak handrail sets the tone for the quality found throughout. To the front, the sitting room is enhanced by a bay window and provides a bright, welcoming space. The rear of the house is centred around a stunning kitchen/living room – a contemporary kitchen with island and breakfast bar flows into a sociable dining and snug area, complete with inset wood-burning stove. Sliding doors open directly onto the terrace, perfect for entertaining. A separate utility room, beautifully finished bathroom and integral garage add valuable storage and practicality. Upstairs, four well-proportioned bedrooms are served by a contemporary shower room.

To the front, a driveway provides off-road parking and leads to the integral garage. At the rear, a raised terrace offers the ideal spot for al fresco dining, with steps leading down to a lawned garden, vegetable beds and greenhouse. A useful cellar sits beneath the terrace, providing additional storage.

The house enjoys a highly convenient setting. Families will appreciate St Nicholas' Primary School just at the end of the road, while Clevedon's town centre, seafront, shops and cafes on Hill Road, and beautiful woodland walks are all within easy reach. This is a rare opportunity to acquire a 1930s hillside home that combines period charm with modern living, generous gardens and an outstanding location.





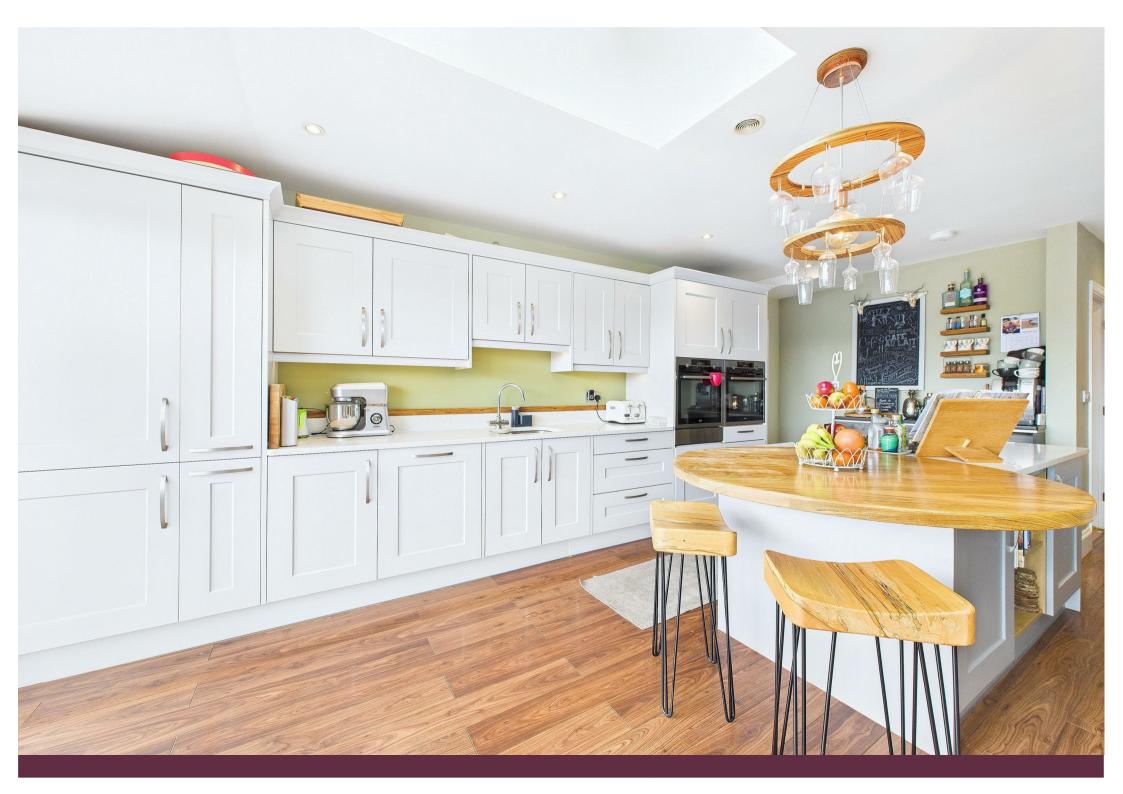
