Belgrave Place, BN2

Elevated on the second floor of a striking Grade II listed townhouse tucked away from Kemp Town Seafront on Belgrave Place, this attractive one-bedroom apartment is a real gem. It has generous rooms with tall sash windows framing sea views, and the relaxed café culture of Kemp Town Village nearby. It has been a hugely successful rental property due to its sea views, location and exceptional interior, so it will appeal to first-time buyers, professionals and investors alike.

Bearing the classical architectural features of the era, the town homes of Belgrave Place are striking with lonic pillars and glossy black railings picked out against creamy facades. The entrance to this apartment is in a house on the westerly corner facing south, with a grand entrance opening to neat communal ways. Stairs rise to the second floor where this apartment is clearly numbered.

Stepping inside, the eye is drawn along the hall to the living room where the expert interior design is evident. Herringbone oak flooring is paired with fresh white walls and natural light streams in from the south through two tall sash windows. Running along the rear wall, the kitchen is a stylish addition with dark cabinetry off-set by white stone worktops and marbled splashbacks to complement. Brushed gold door furniture and taps add warmth and a luxury finish. In a room of this size, there is ample space for formal dining and relaxation, for socialising or simply relaxing in the evening.

Moving through the flat, the bedroom is peacefully positioned to the rear, looking out over the historic city landscape of Kemp Town Village. Wood flooring pairs perfectly with sage green, built-in wardrobes leaving plenty of space for a double bed. Next door, the bathroom follows the same palette as the kitchen with a dark vanity units below a gleaming white basin and bath, combined with marbled panelling to the shower.


