# Stanley Street, BN2

Elevated on the hill, on a peaceful road between Hanover and Kemptown sits this sweet and sunny two-bedroom Victorian terraced house. It sits mid-terrace on Stanley Street which forms part of the colourful character of Hanover with houses painted in a rainbow of colours to brighten any grey day. From the front of the house, you can see the sea from the hillside, beckoning you down during summer for sea swims or blustery winter walks along the prom.







Stepping inside, it feels more spacious than its modest façade would suggest, yet it has the feel of a cottage in the sitting room which is immediately warm and welcoming. It has plenty of character with a period fireplace to sit round during winter, alongside space for a small dining table below the window. Next door, the kitchen is equally charming with modern-country style cabinetry and chequerboard splashbacks adding a pop of colour. While the oven and gas hob are integrated, space has been left for an under-counter fridge and a washing machine, plus there is space for a kitchen table for informal meals.

These can spill outside to the patio garden which becomes a wonderful extension of the space during summer. It is decked for easy maintenance and has tall fencing to ensure privacy from neighbouring homes. With an open westerly aspect, the sun bathes the space during the afternoon and evening when it is a lovely space to sit out with friends for summery suppers and drinks.

Completing the ground floor, the bathroom is classic in white and grey, so you can add a pop of colour with toiletries and towels. Much like the kitchen, it is a smart and functional space with a shower over the bath, yet there is scope to add value with modernisation.

Upstairs, the bedrooms are both double with soft carpet underfoot and built-in wardrobes and shelves within their alcoves. Both rooms have period fireplaces with wooden mantels for decoration and energy efficient double-glazed windows ensure a restful night's sleep.
