In fact, the Cathedral proved to be so impressive that it featured on the British £20 note to commemorate renowned composer Sir Edward Elgar between 1999 and 2007.

The Cathedral is more than a beautiful building; it's a fantastic place to visit with the family especially for those who are keen to immerse themselves in history.
