The property

This charming detached period cottage offers accommodation of character and is attractively situated in the Quantock Hills. The property exhibits many wonderful period features including a inglenook fireplace. The property has oil-fired central heating and is mostly double glazed. The property offers scope for improvement and enlargement, subject to the usual consents. The grounds extend to about 0.7 acres and include a stream.

The accommodation

The entrance porch opens to the dining reception hall with inglenook fireplace and tiled floor. The sitting room also has a stone faced fireplace and enjoys a lovely triple aspect with French doors opening to the rear garden. The study also has French doors opening to the side garden. Situated to the rear of the house is the kitchen/breakfast room with doors to the conservatory and a rear covered way. Also on the ground floor can be found a shower room.

First floor

The principal bedroom enjoys a lovely double aspect with rural views and has an en suite







bathroom. The second bedroom is also of a good size and has lovely rural views. The third bedroom looks over the rear garden and there is also a family bathroom.

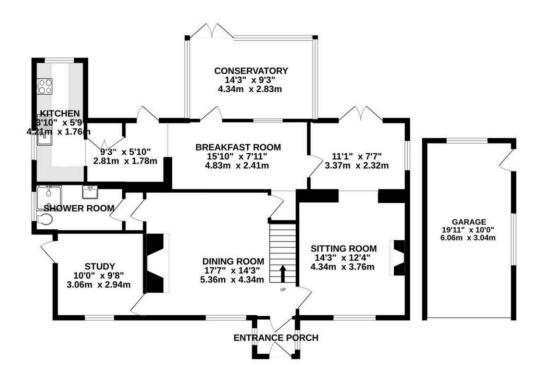
Outside

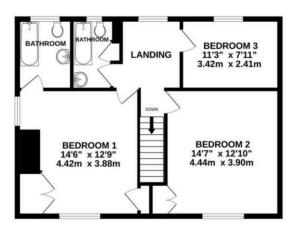
The gardens and grounds provide a wonderful setting for the property and in total they extend to about 0.7 acres. A driveway provides parking and gives access to the garage. The gardens are mainly lawned and include mature trees and shrubs and are part bounded by a stream.

Situation

Plainsfield is a small hamlet situated in the Quantock Hills which are designated a National Landscape and an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. There are a number of footpaths and bridleways nearby allowing direct access to miles of open countryside. The nearby village of Over Stowey has a Church and village hall, whilst the larger village of Nether Stowey has shops and amenities for day to day needs. The large centres of Taunton and Bridgwater are also readily accessible.
