The property

This individual detached chalet bungalow is believed to date from the 1950's and has been designed to take full advantage of the wonderful setting. It offers huge potential for redevelopment and enlargement, subject to the usual consents. The property enjoys a glorious southerly aspect with all the main rooms enjoying views over the stunning gardens. The gardens extend to about 0.8 acres and are stocked with an abundance of mature shrubs and trees. The garden includes numerous magnolias, camellias and azaleas and numerous specimen trees including tulip, ginkgo and Judas.

The accommodation

The property is approached via an entrance porch which opens into a large dining hall, with stairs to the first floor. The sitting room has been extended to provide a garden room with fitted sitting and glorious views over the garden. The kitchen leads through to the rear hallway with built in store room and providing access to the principal bedroom which enjoys a wonderful double aspect. There is an adjacent shower







room. There are 2 further ground floor bedrooms and a family bathroom. On the first floor is a large sitting room/bedroom 4, again with wonderful southerly views over the garden.

Outside

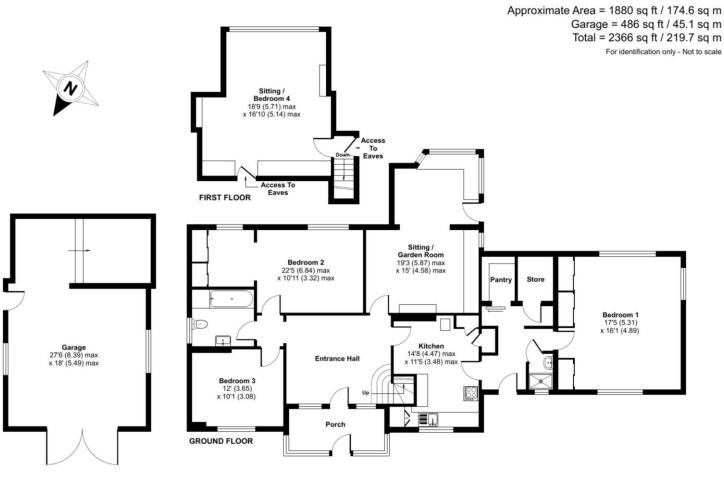
The gardens extend to about 0.8 of an acre and are stocked with an abundance of mature shrubs and trees. They are gently sloping and enjoy a wonderful southerly aspect. A large driveway provides ample parking and gives access to the detached garage. The garden offers potential for sub-division to incorporate a building plot, subject to the usual consents and regulations.

Situation

The property occupies a stunning setting on the edge of this sought after village, nestling in the lower slopes of the Quantock hills, which are designated a National Landscape (former AONB). The village provides an active community with fine parish Church, Italian restaurant/pub and nearby at Monkton Heathfield can be found a village hall, convenience store, the Merry Monk pub and Silvers Pantry breakfast restaurant.
