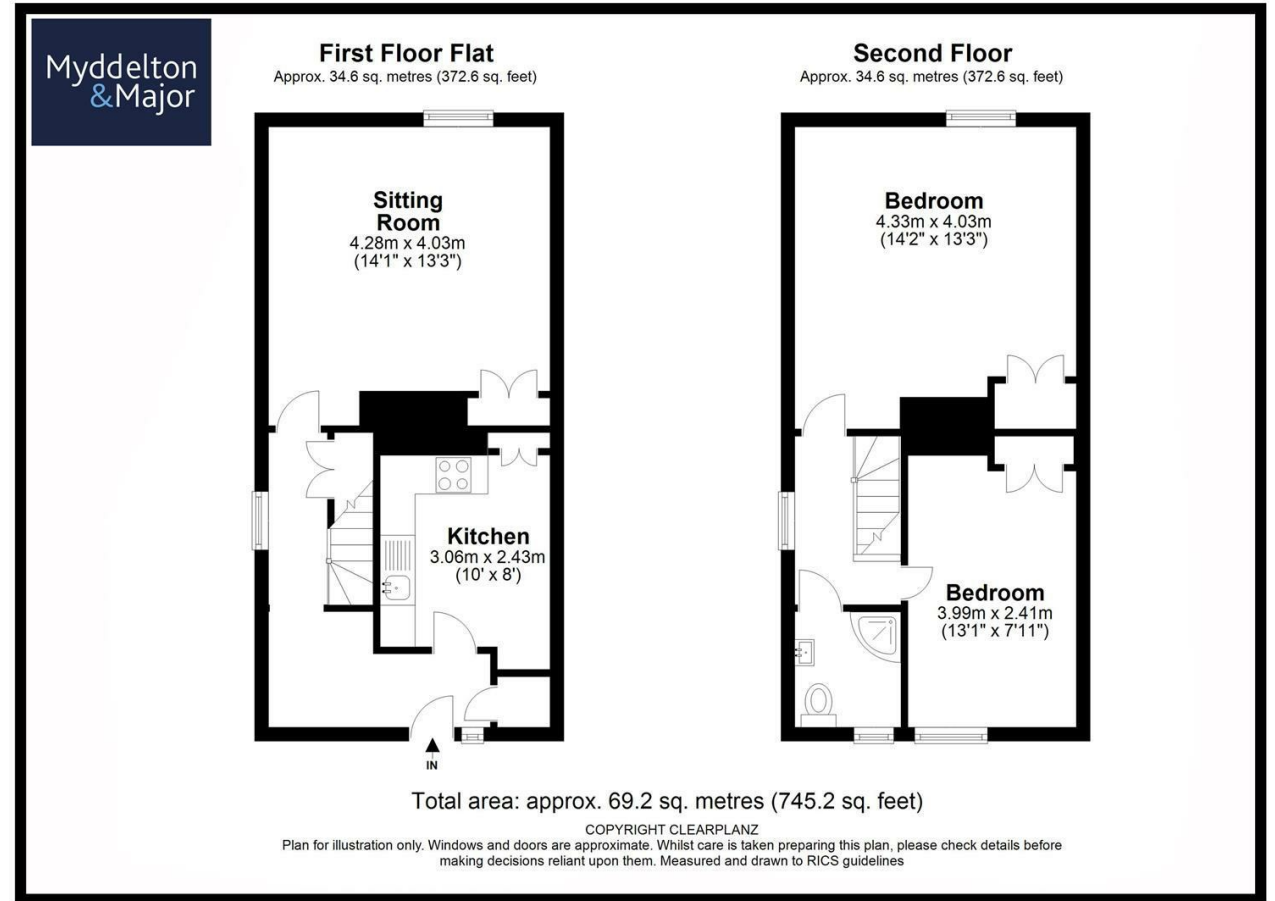
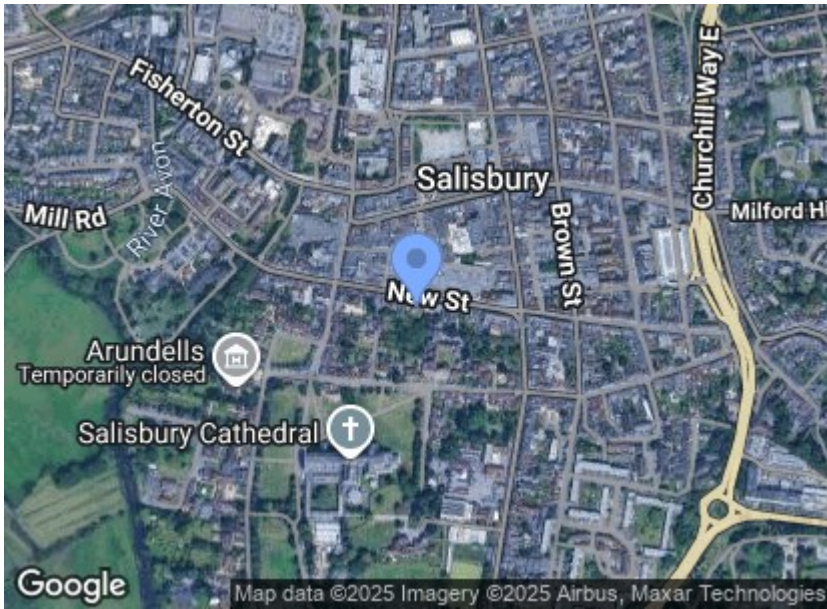

The property has been fully renovated, opening into the brand new comfortable kitchen, equipped with integrated appliances and larder, and the hallway which flows into the spacious sitting room looking out over the bustling New Street, benefitting from an abundance of built-in storage. Upstairs hosts the two generous double bedrooms and modern shower room, with the rear windows providing an outstanding view of the Cathedral overlooking the courtyard.

This first and second floor flat forms part of a large period property set in an attractive row of historic buildings backing on to The Close's curtain wall, and is located right in the heart of the cathedral city of Salisbury. New Street is a vibrant street with a variety of pubs, restaurants and independent shops, being a stone's throw from the city centre and a short walk from Salisbury's excellent range of cultural, education and shopping amenities. This is also within walking distance of the mainline train station to London Waterloo (approximately 90 minutes).





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
