Impressive stone built property renovated over the last five years and a true cottage in every sense of the word with bags of charm and character. The property has been 'taken back to the brick' and all the plumbing, wiring, fixtures and fittings have been renewed and replaced in that time. The accommodation briefly comprises: entrance porch, lounge, fitted kitchen with quartz counter tops, first floor landing, two bedrooms and a three piece shower room. To the outside there is a low maintenance garden to the front and to the rear a garden area which has been paved in porcelain tiling.

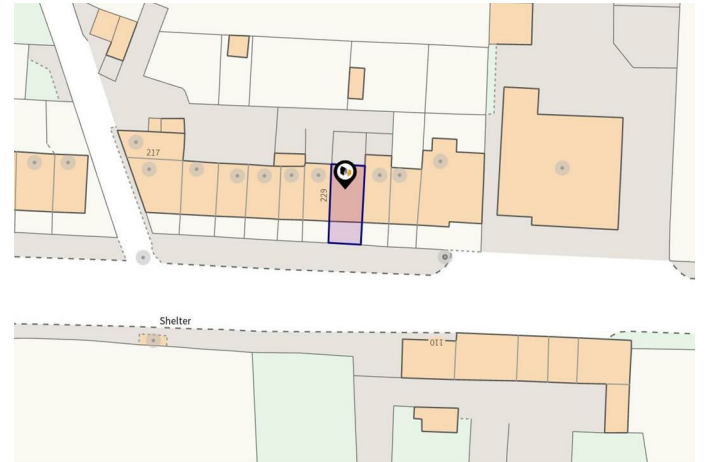
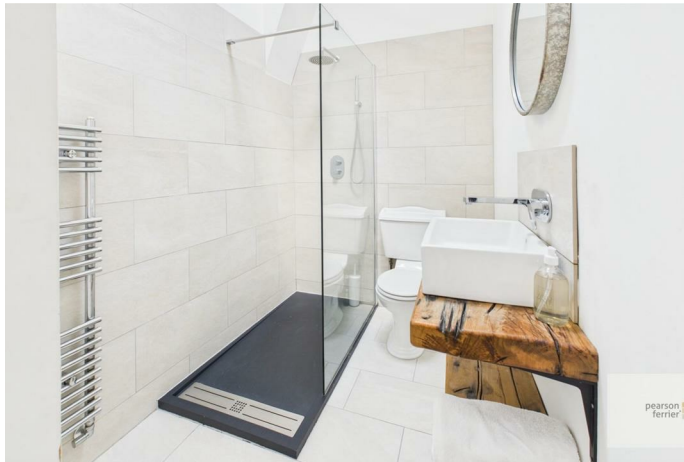

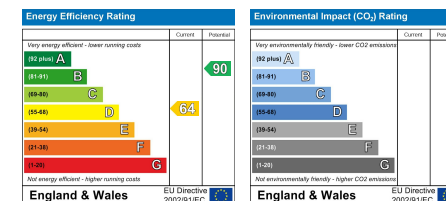
