ENTRANCE

Spacious entrance hallway.

LOUNGE

Good size main reception space with two double glazed windows, gas fire with decorative surround and central heating radiator. Double doors to...

KITCHEN

Modern fitted wall and base units to three sides with a contrasting work surface over incorporating a stainless steel sink and mixer tap. Double electric oven, gas hob and integrated dishwasher. Vinyl flooring and double glazed window.

BEDROOM

A double bedroom with double glazed window, central heating radiator and fitted robes.

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BATHROOM

Large bathroom with fitted three piece bathroom suite in white. Shower and screen over bath. Double glazed window, part tiling to the walls and vinyl flooring.
