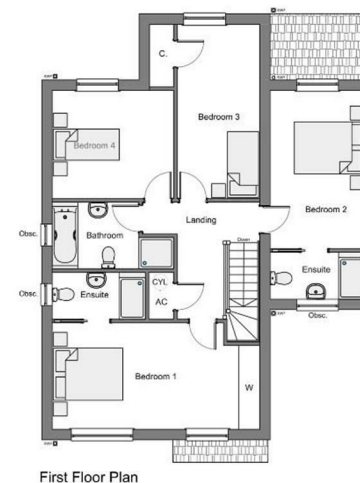
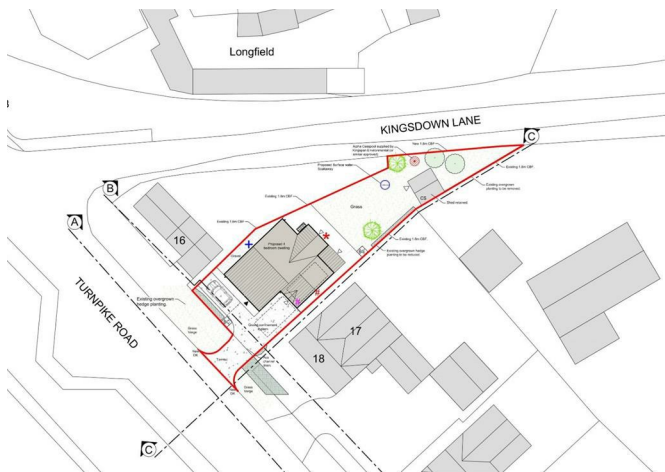

OUTLINE PLANNING PERMISSION GRANTED for a four bedroom, reception, kitchen diner, utility, cloakroom, four piece bathroom, two en-suites, detached dwelling with a single garage.

SERVICES - there are no services currently connected to the plot, this will need to be sourced from the main road. Sewage will need to be via a private sewage treatment plant or septic tank on site, there is no sewage currently on site of any kind.

CIL LIABILITY - Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) to Swindon Borough Council as CIL Collecting Authority. Self build exemption available.

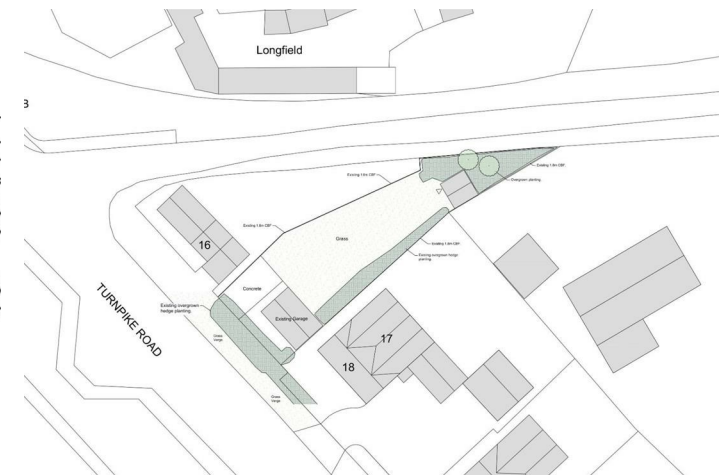

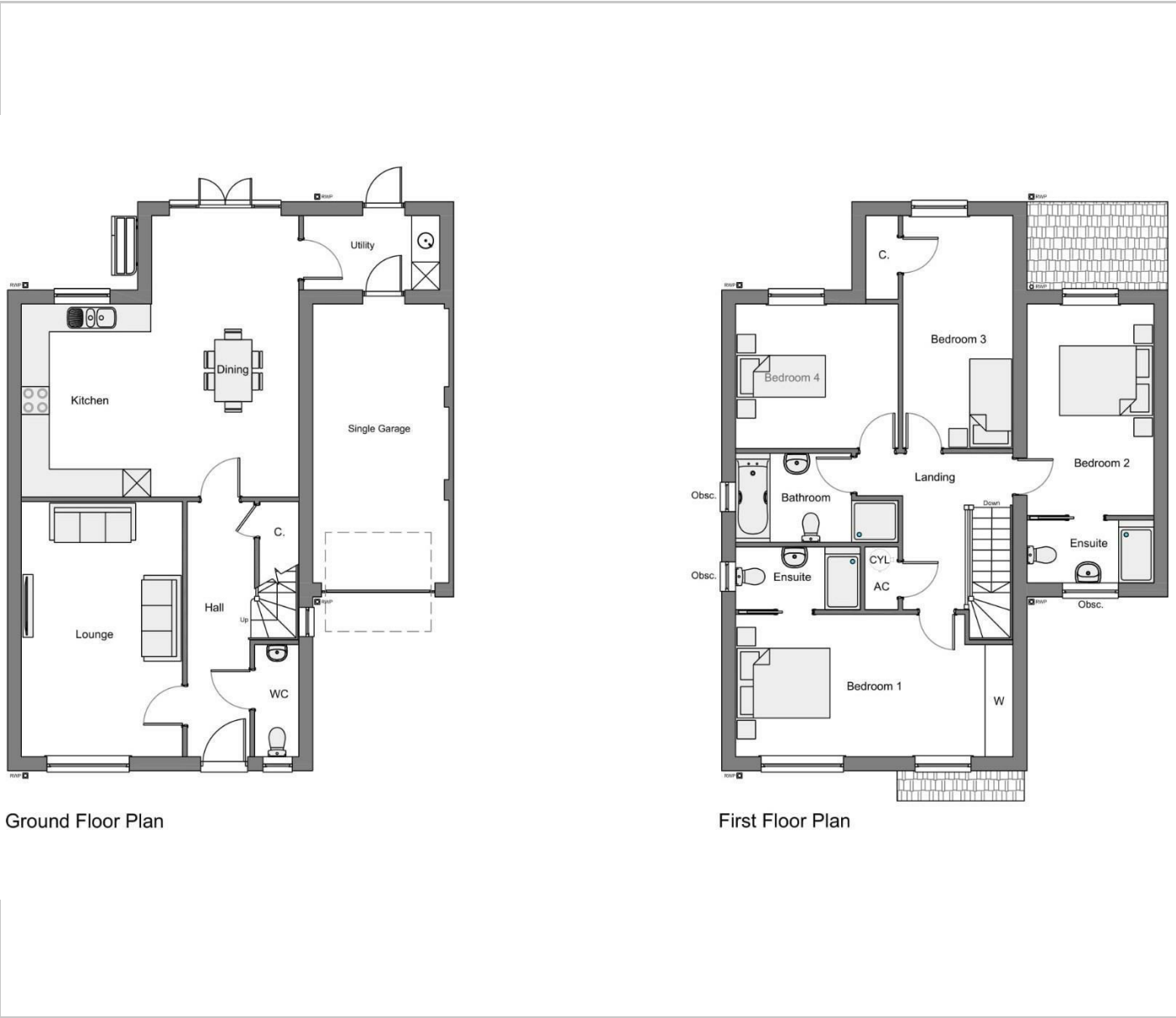


Situation

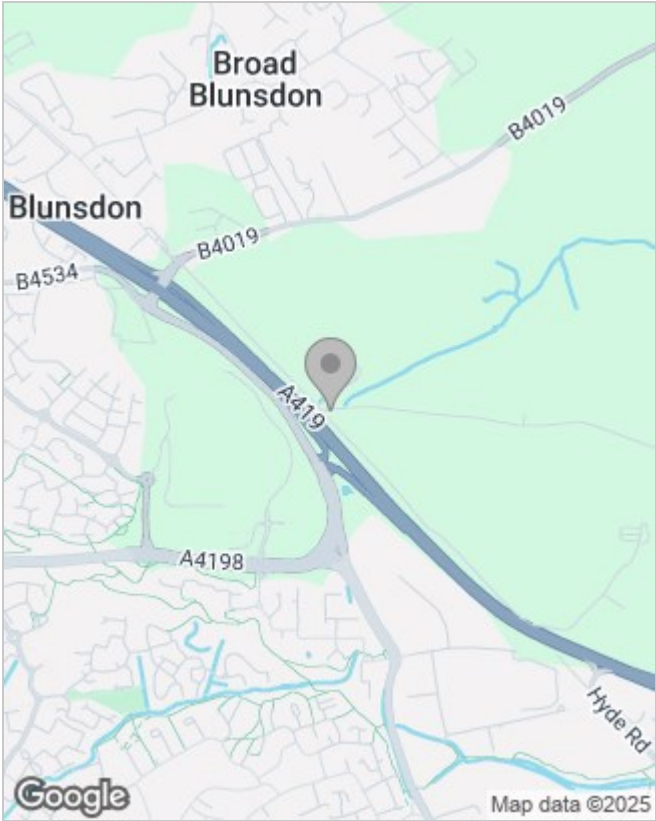
Blunsdon is a village situated on the immediate periphery of Swindon, providing good access to many commuter links via train and road.
