DIRECTIONS TO ORCHIDS PLACE

From the M4 - At junction 10, exit onto A329(M) towards Wokingham/Bracknell, Take the A329/B3408 exit towards Wokingham/Binfield. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto London Rd/BS408, take the second exit at the next two roundabouts. At Framptons Bridge Roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Harvest Ride and the next 1st exit onto Sopwith Road. Continue along this road until the next roundabout where Orchids Place will be on your right.
