
LOCATIONCANARY WHARF



It will be Europe's largest and most technologically advanced commercial lab and will provide 823,000 sq. ft, across 23 storeys, of state-of-the-art laboratory, office and innovation space for some of the most exciting and fast-growing businesses in the health and life science sector. It will be capable of delivering CL2 lab space on every floor as well as GMP, high containment and affiliated space.
