Rear aspect window, carpet flooring & radiator


Bathroom 5'2" x 6'6" (1.6 x 2.0)

Side aspect privacy window, vinyl flooring, tiled walls, 3 piece suite, electric shower over the bath & electric towel radiator


Area Map
