## Entrance Hall

The property has a double glazed entrance door to the side aspect. Storage cupboard and loft access hatch. Radiator.

## Lounge

## Kitchen

10'0" x 7'0" (3.07 x 2.15)

A double glazed window overlooks the front aspect. Fitted with a range of wall and base storage units with inset stainless steel sink unit and side drainer. Coordinating work surface areas and partly tiled walls. Integrated electric oven and induction hob with cooker hood above. Space and plumbing for fridge/freezer and washing machine. Tiled flooring. Wall

mounted central heating boiler.

## Bedroom One

10'6" x 10'2" (3.22 x 3.12)

A double glazed window overlooks the rear aspect. Fitted with a range of wardrobes. Television point and radiator.

## Bedroom Two

8'5" x 6'11" (2.59 x 2.11)

A double glazed window overlooks the rear aspect. Radiator.

## Shower Room

6'3" x 5'5" (1.91 x 1.67)

A double glazed window overlooks the side aspect. Fitted with a walk in shower, vanity hand wash basin and low level W.C. Partly tiled walls and flooring. Ceiling spotlights and extractor fan. Ladder style towel radiator.

To the front the property has a

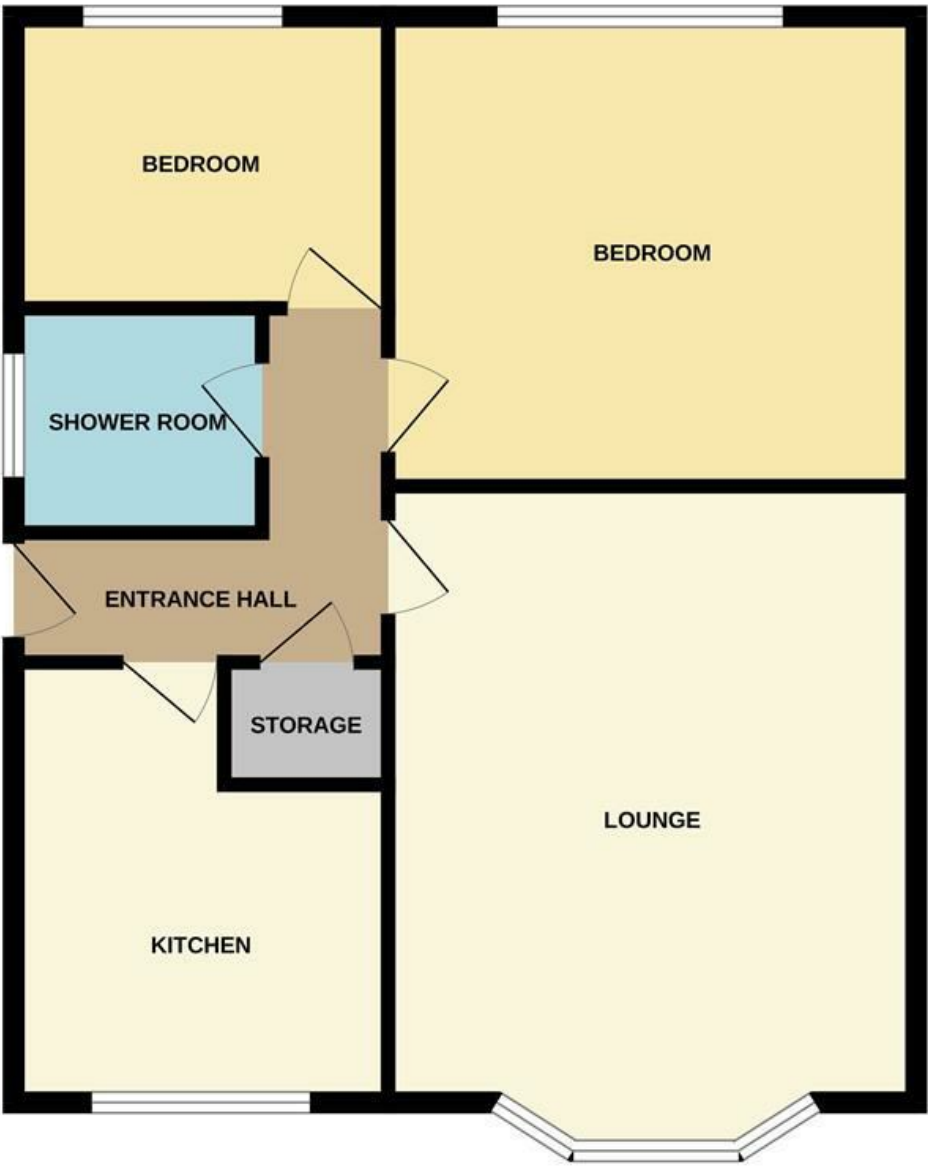
