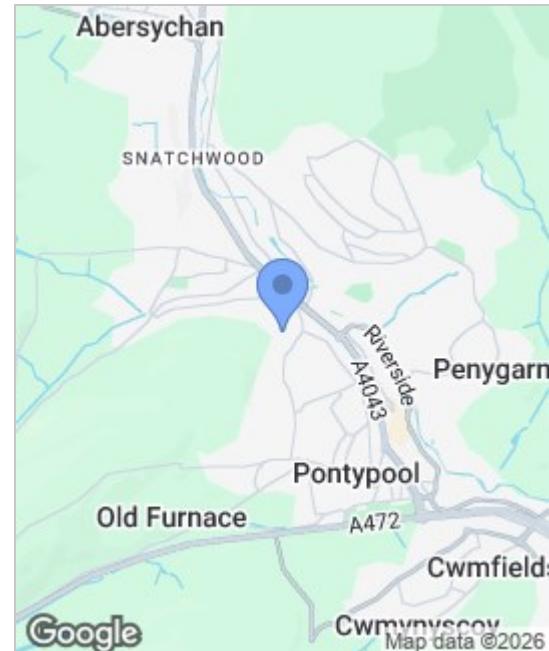
Externally, the property boasts an enclosed rear garden with a patio and lawn, along with a gate providing rear access. Additional brick-built storage is located beneath the house.
