The accommodation of some 2085 sq ft comprises as follows; the large entrance hall is an attractive and welcoming space in its own right that leads to the principal reception room with feature fireplace and bay window, there is a good sized study or an ideal play room and a W.C/cloak room. We then move onto the vast open plan kitchen living space extending to 24' and featuring a snug area with fitted storage and wall mounted tv, dining space and of course the petrol blue fitted kitchen, complemented with light grey stone worktops and a host of integrated appliances including; double ovens, fridge freezer, wine cooler, dishwasher, induction hob and overhead extractor. Flooded with light thanks to the bi folding doors and Velux windows in the part vaulted ceiling this really is a fantastic space that needs to be seen to be fully appreciated. Upstairs is equally impressive and beautifully finished comprising four bedrooms, three of which boast fitted wardrobes and the master bedroom with an en suite shower room. Additionally the family bathroom offers both a walk in shower and bath and is finished with white marble and his and hers sink. Externally the rear garden extends to approximately 129' with a south westerly aspect. There is a large paved patio and outbuilding that currently functions as an office and gym. To the front of the property the driveway provides off road parking for a number of vehicles.

Located on a popular and sought after residential road, just a short distance from West Wickham High Street and with the benefit of Cheyne Wood being at the end of the road offering pleasant walks and a country feel. There are a number of popular schools catering for both primary and secondary and West Wickham Station offers services to London Bridge & Charing Cross. 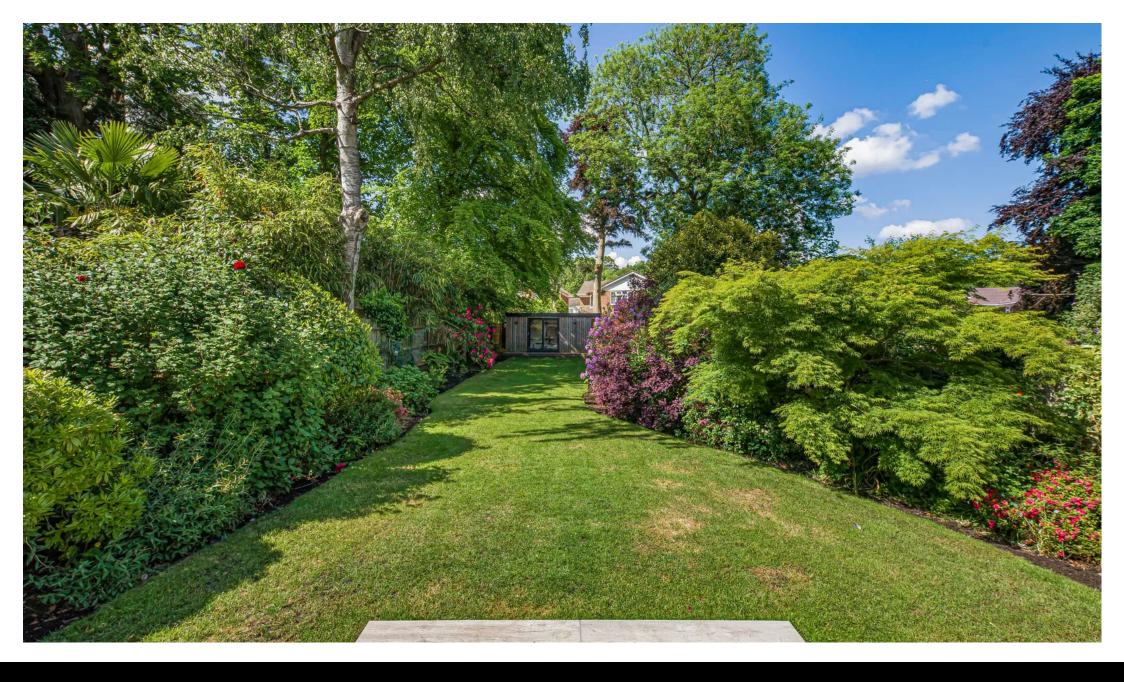
