Ashfield dates back to the late 18th Century and has beautifully proportioned, elegant accommodation that has been comprehensively and sympathetically restored by the current owners.

The entrance hall has a tessellated floor and stairs rising to the first floor. On the right is the sitting room with wood burning stove and full height French doors to the garden, the dining room opposite is similarly proportioned with matching French doors. There is a utility room, shower room and contemporary Mayflower kitchen with American Fridge Freezer. A door from the kitchen opens into the charming courtyard enclosed by a historic stone wall.

The bathroom on the half landing has an attractive stained glass window set into the door and a short flight of stairs lead up to the three bedrooms on the first floor, all of which overlook the front garden. On the top floor are two further bedrooms.

Standing behind cast iron railings, Ashfield is well set back from the road with a front garden laid to lawn and path meandering up to the front door. There is an attached store room with access at the front and rear and two private parking spaces within a short walk of the house.


This is a rare opportunity to acquire a wonderful period home in this popular market town and viewing is highly recommended.
