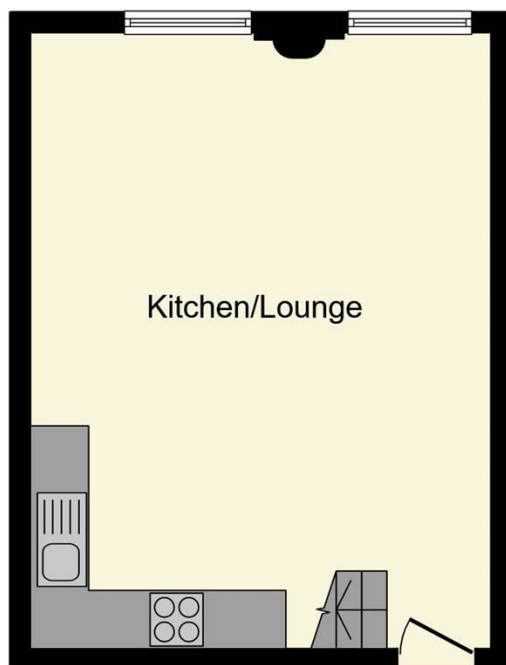
About Rugby

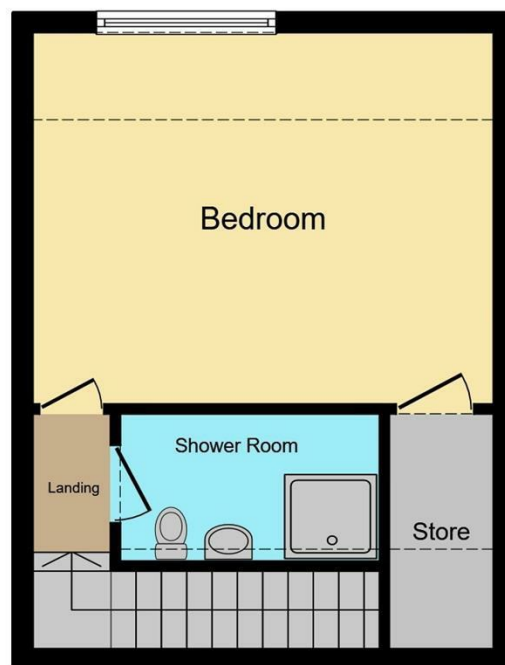

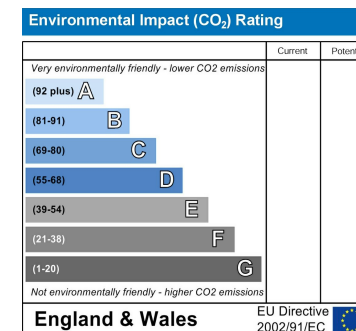
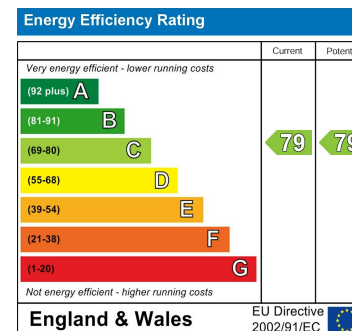
