BEDROOM FOUR 11'2" x 7'11" (3.40 x 2.41)

TV point. Built in wardrobe. Double glazed window to rear.

FAMILY BATHROOM

Low flush WC. Wash hand basin. Bath. Tiled splash areas. Radiator. Shaver socket. Extractor fan. Down lighters. Window to front.

OUTSIDE

Front garden laid to lawn. Driveway leading to a double garage entered via two single up and over doors. Power and light connected. Personal door to rear. Loft storage.

Rear garden laid to lawn with patio and enclosed fencing.





