Offered to the market for the first time in over 50 years, this beautifully preserved stone-built semi-detached property, dating back to the mid-1700s, is rich in heritage and filled with warmth. Lovingly maintained by the same family for decades, the home combines historic charm with modern comfort, making it a truly rare and special find.

At its heart lies a classic Shaker-style kitchen with solid fuel heating, while the rest of the property benefits from modern gas central heating, creating a cosy, characterful atmosphere throughout. It comprises; vestibule, kitchen leading through to conservatory, utility room and lounge. From the vestibule there is a stairway leading down to a boarded cellar room benefitting from windows and power. To the top floor there are three bedrooms and a three piece bathroom suite. The property internally is modern, but has kept a lot of its character, with beamed ceilings and exposed stone work. Externally there is a generous plot to the front, adequate for multiple vehicles along with motorhomes/horse boxes. To the rear there is a neat courtyard with access to a long strip of lawn. Along with this there is a detached storage outbuilding which we feel is an excellent addition for any trades uses.





