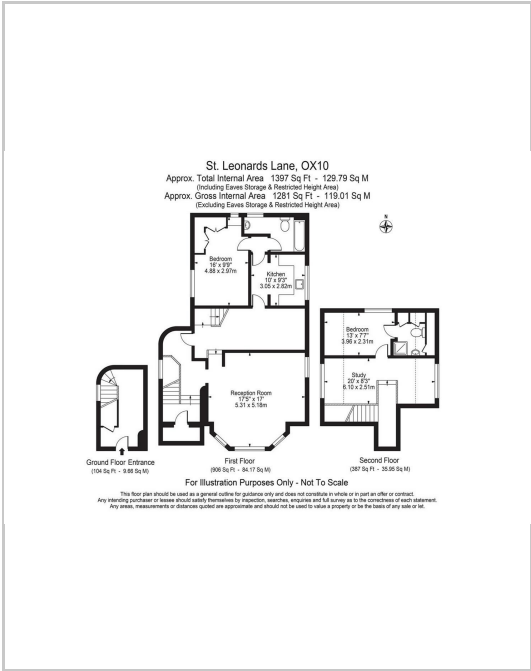

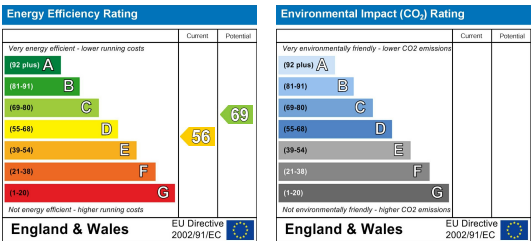
Area Map
