# **Trelawny Road**

Tavistock

Offering scope for modernisation and updating is this end of terrace 2 bedroom period town house, together with rear courtyard and store sheds, front garden and within a few steps of the property is a good sized garden to the rear. Enjoying views across the town and countryside beyond.

The property, which has night storage heating, briefly comprises; Gabled entrance porch, sitting room with bay window and open fire. Kitchen giving access to a rear porch with airing cupboard and electric immersion heater, leading to a ground floor bathroom. Stairs from the kitchen rise to a first floor landing with walk in store, main bedroom enjoying superb views across the town and countryside beyond, second bedroom with built in wardrobes and a door into an en suite toilet.

Outside, a shared pedestrian pathway leads to the front door and front gardens. The path continues to the rear where there is a courtyard with two useful store sheds in need of repair. To the rear of the store sheds a further pathway leads to a generous garden with mature tree, apple tree and mainly laid to lawn enjoying spectacular views.


#### Situation

There is a pedestrian right of way to the rear of the property.


# Floor Plan




