

Parkwood Court, Tavistock, Guide Price £115,000

Situated in the popular retirement development of Parkwood Court, is this ground floor, one bedroom apartment, for the over 55s only. The community at Parkwood Court have many activities including Knit and Natter and group lunches, held in the communal lounge. The apartment is only a short level walk from the bustling town centre and set within delightful communal well tended gardens.

The accommodation, which is double glazed and with night storage heating, together with emergency pull cords, can be approached either from the main entrance and communal hallway, or via its own private door in the gardens to the rear of the property, where there is a small flower bed. The living room has an open aspect over the gardens and an electric woodburning effect fire with surround. An archway opens into a comprehensively fitted kitchen with wall and base units, freestanding fridge/freezer, built in electric oven and ceramic hob, 1.5 bowl sink unit and tiled splashback. The generous double bedroom has fitted furniture, including dressing table, wardrobes, overhead storage and bedside tables. There is a shower room with electric Mira shower and seat, low level we and vanity wash basin with cupboards below. Within the hallway is in an airing cupboard with hot water heater.

The gardens are well tended with various seating areas to enjoy outside or sunshine.

Situation

Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town located on the edge of the Dartmoor National Park. The town offers a wide range of local and national shops whilst also boasting the renowned pannier market, riverside park, leisure centre and theatre.
