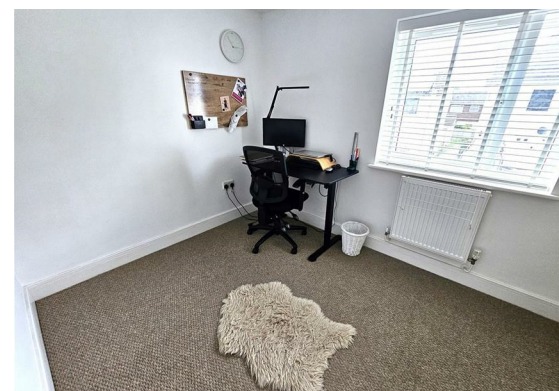

WITH OWN GARDEN and NO ONWARD CHAIN. A much improved, detached coach house set in a sought after cul-de-sac location on the fringe of Tavistock. This two double bedroom home offers well proportioned rooms, with Bedroom One offering an ensuite facility and also greatly benefitting from it's own private garden, accessed via a side gate or from the rear of the garage.

The property has been modernised to create a stylish and generous open plan living space with attractive modern kitchen, with breakfast bar, fully fitted with integrated appliances. From the inner hall doors lead to the two bedrooms, both with fitted wardrobes. The master bedroom boasts an en suite with large walk in shower and the main bathroom has a bath with shower over. The light and airy property boasts off road parking, together with a spacious garage beneath which benefits from power and lighting and access to its own private garden laid to lawn, enclosed by wooden fencing.

Accommodation briefly comprises: Entrance hall, Open plan Living room and Kitchen, Inner hallway, Two Double Bedrooms (One Ensuite), Family bathroom, Garage and Garden.

Situation

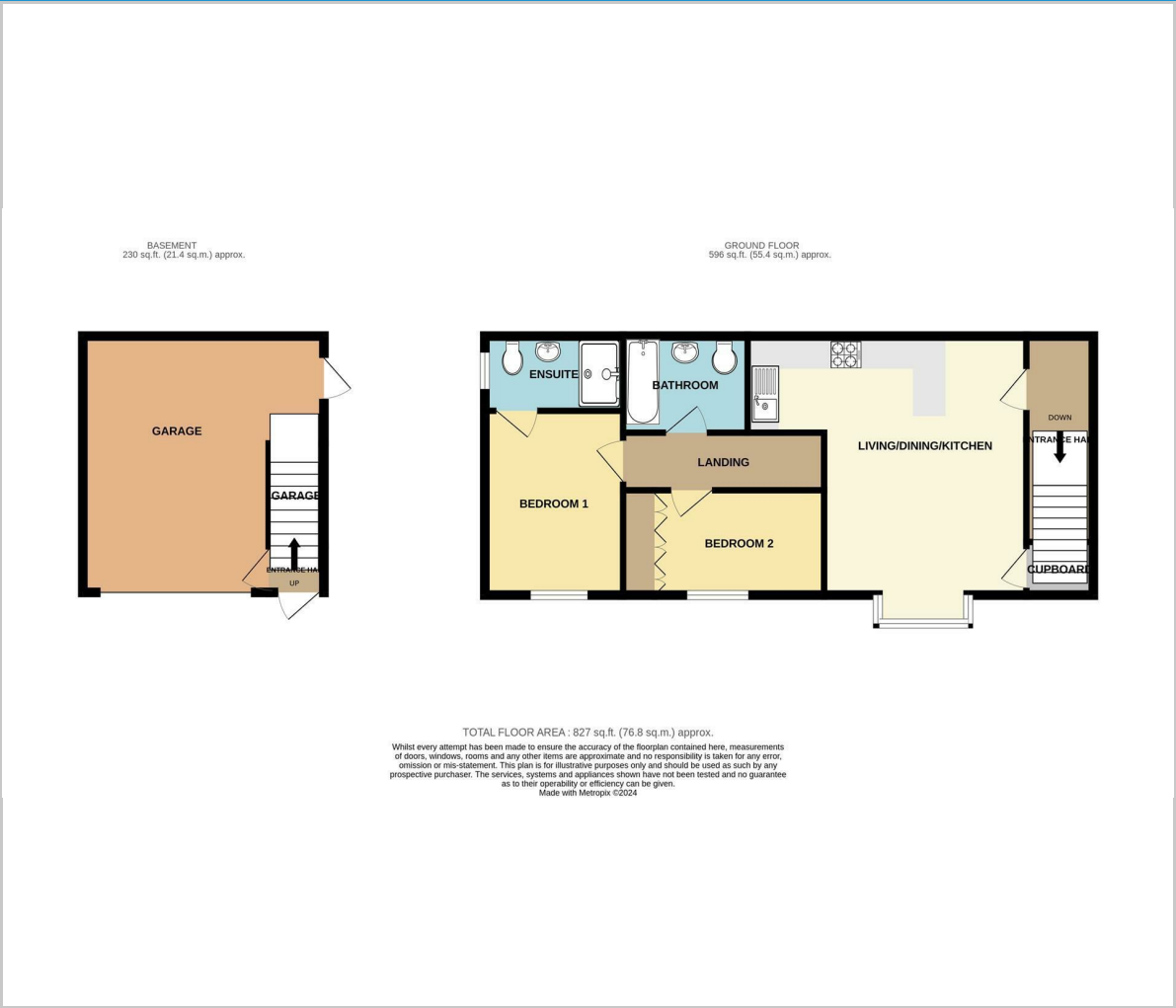
Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town located on the edge of the Dartmoor National Park. The town offers a wide range of local and national shops whilst also boasting the renowned pannier market, riverside park, leisure centre and theatre. The area is excellent for visitors both to see the town itself and for exploring the surrounding countryside, the wild Dartmoor scenery and the many neighbouring pretty villages and a variety of National Trust properties. There are exceptional educational facilities in both the state and private sector. The town itself has fantastic sporting facilities including, tennis courts, a bowls club, athletics track and various football pitches. For golf enthusiasts, there are excellent golf courses nearby, at Yelverton and Tavistock and St. Mellion. There are also opportunities to fish by arrangement on a number of local rivers, including the Walkham, Tavy and Tamar.

Floor Plan



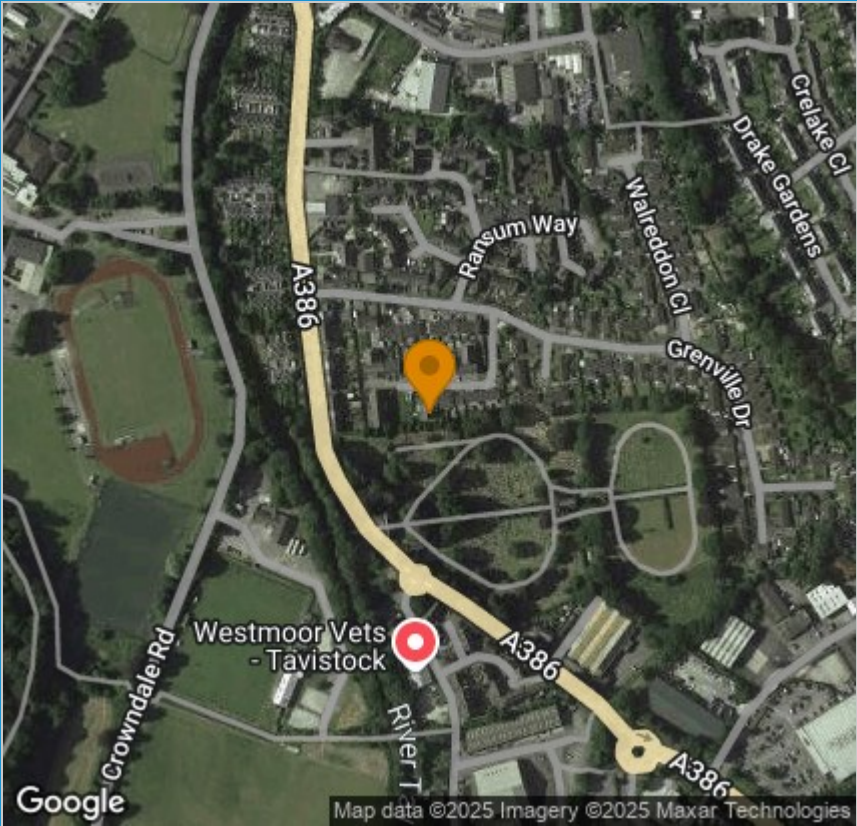
