The family bathroom features a modern walk-in shower, white WC, and hand basin.

Outside:

In addition to the small rear courtyard and front garden, the property also enjoys a further garden space set just behind, accessed via a path. Mainly laid to lawn and complemented by scenic views towards the estuary, it's an ideal spot to relax and unwind. A brick-built storage shed is also located directly behind the property.

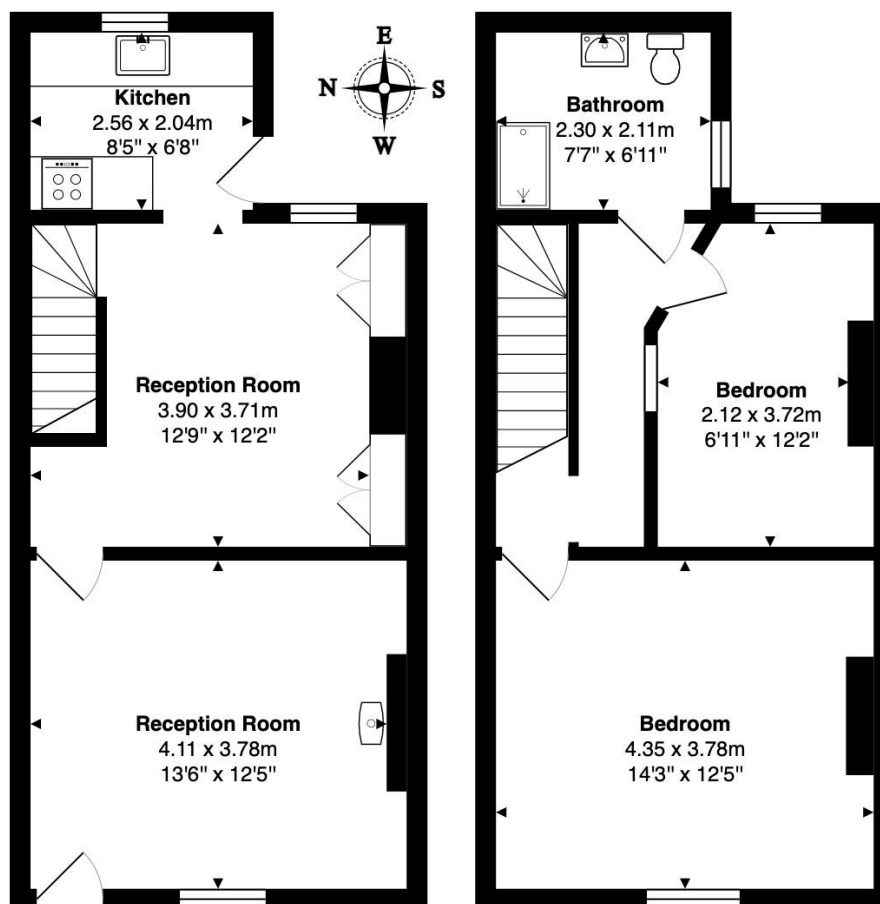

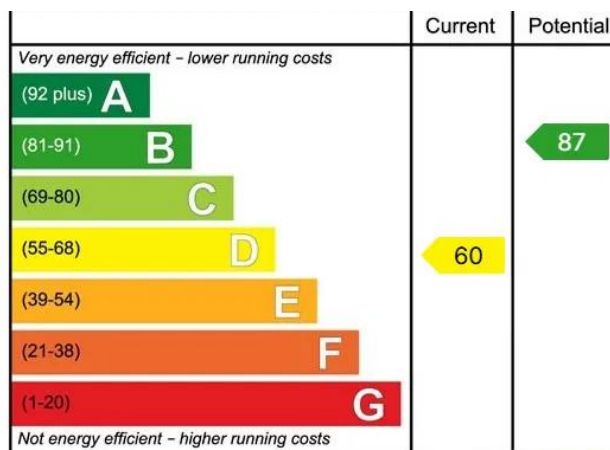
