

Shared Ownership IN PARTNERSHIP WITH BIELD HOUSING & CARE

What is Shared Ownership?

Shared Ownership is a scheme that enables people to buy a home without funding the full market value of the property.

How it works

There are five apartments available to purchase at Moncrieff View using the shared ownership scheme. Buyers will purchase a 75% share of the home and the remaining 25% will be owned by Bield Housing & Care and is subject to a monthly occupancy charge.

Example Illustration



Apartment price £260,000



You fund 75% share at £195,000 using cash or a mortgage

%

25% retained by Bield £65,000 – occupancy charge payable of £175 per month









Who is Eligible?

In order to purchase a home using the Shared Ownership scheme, you must meet the following criteria:

- You must be aged 50 years or over
- The property must be used as your main residence
- The purchaser can earn up to 60% of the median average income, not exceeding £1,230 per month. This excludes pensions and savings
- The purchaser must have a local connection with East Dunbartonshire Council; Lenzie, Kirkintilloch and wider East Dunbartonshire Council area
