A rare and exciting opportunity to acquire a substantial detached commercial property and an adjacent former Mill offering potential for a variety of possible uses and conversion to residential use, subject to planning permission being obtained.

Unconditional cash offers are invited for the freehold interest in this substantial detached commercial property and adjacent former mill.

The buildings have operated for many years as a corn mill, animal feeds business and subsequently as a cafe. The business ceased trading in 2022 and the buildings are now redundant, being offered with vacant possession upon completion.

The properties are held under two titles, CH609280 and CH687882 and the whole site extends to approximately 0.5 of an acre.











DESCRIPTION

The main building comprises of the former cafe with large open plan dining areas and a serving counter. There are toilets and a kitchen. Offices are arranged in the adjacent section of the building with access to first floor rooms used as further offices, general storage and toilet/bathroom. The current business rates valuation is £38,000.

The former mill is a large detached building over three levels. It offers great potential for development and conversion, subject to appropriate planning permission being obtained.

LOCATION

The property is located between the villages of Kingsley and Crowton. Kingsley has a Co-op Store and Post Office and there are pubs in both villages. Popular primary schools are found in both Crowton and Kingsley with secondary education available in Helsby and Weaverham. Kingsley also has an active community with various groups, activities and facilities. The towns of Frodsham and Northwich are both within easy reach and provide more extensive facilities. The location is excellent for access to Delamere Forest and the Weaver Valley which provides extensive walks and bridleways.
