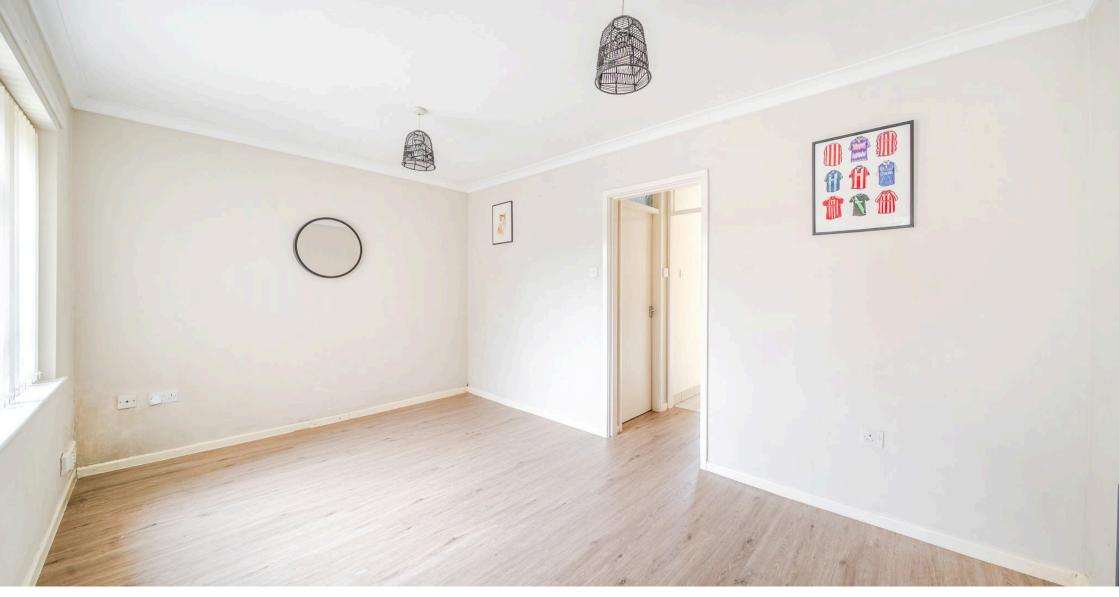

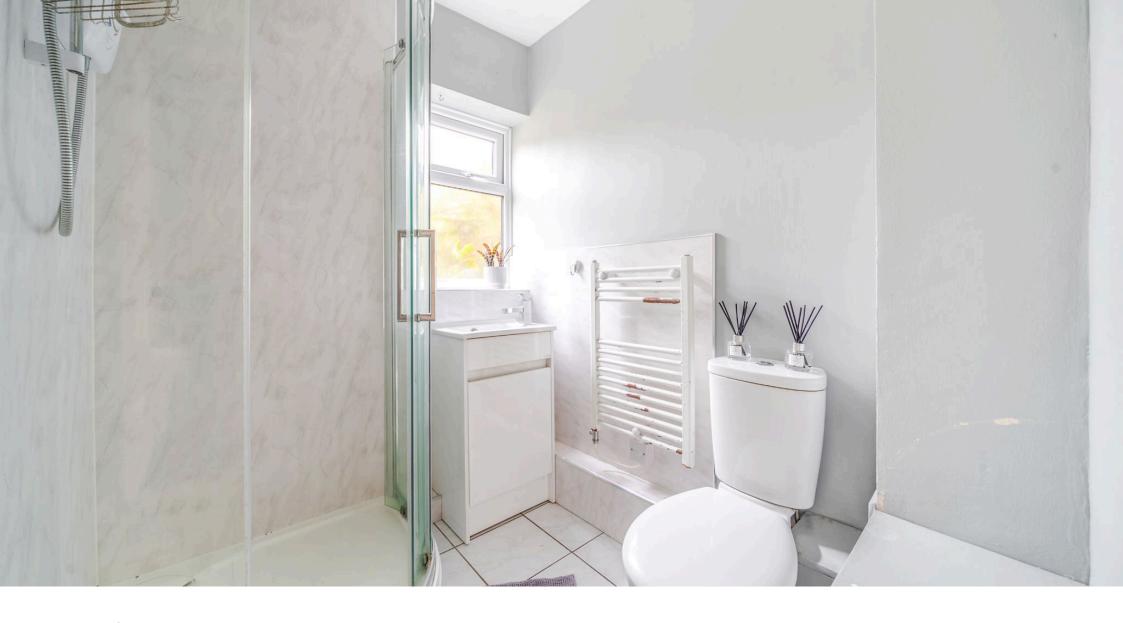




The bedroom

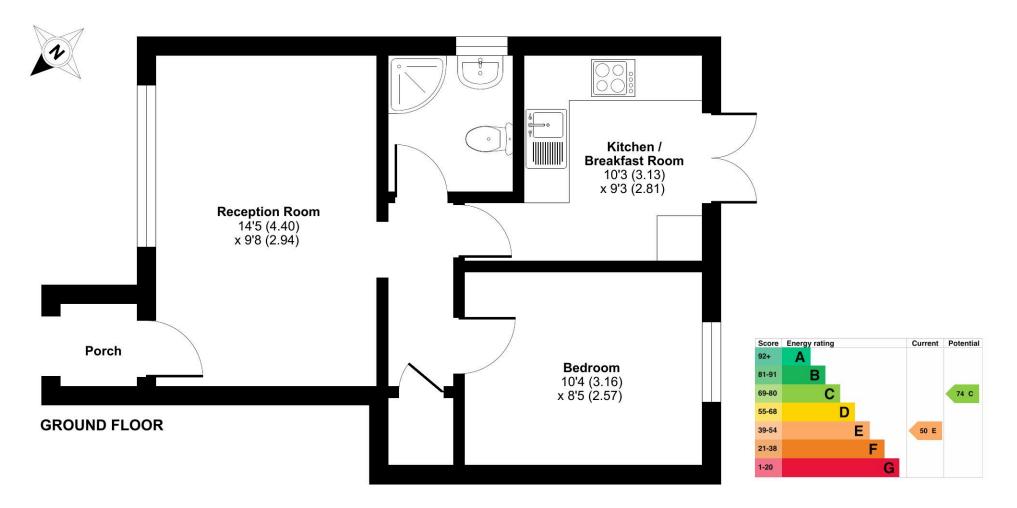
