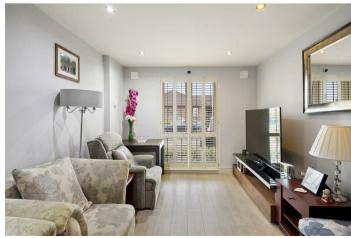
With the added advantage of private seating areas for residents within the communal gardens, lift within the development and allocated parking together with visitors parking in the gated car park.

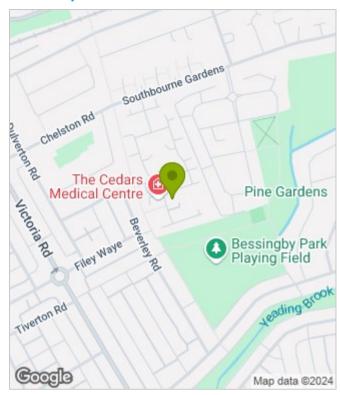




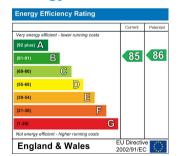
Floor Plans

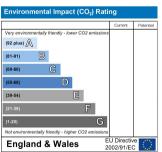
