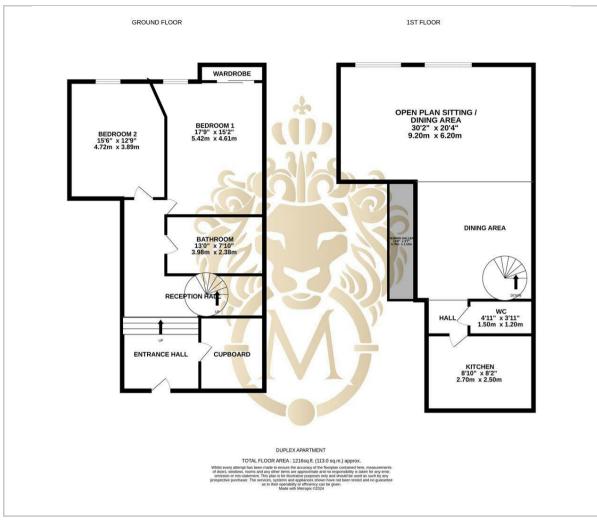

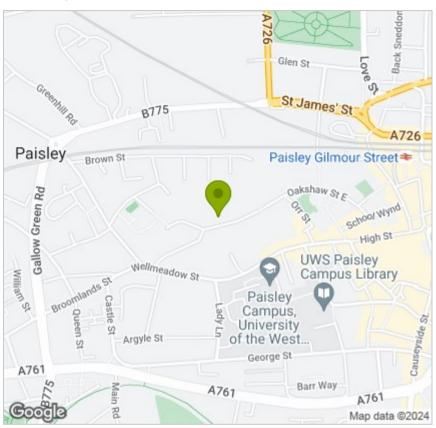
Floor Plan



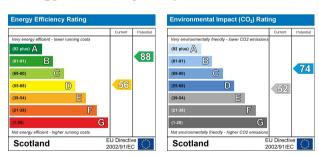
