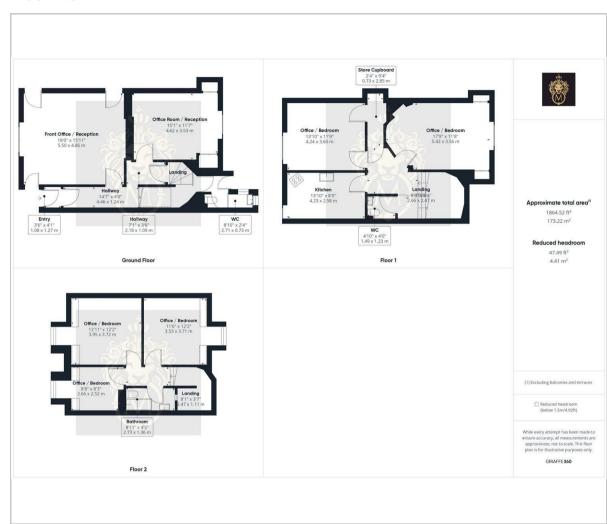

Floor Plan



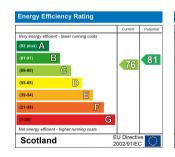

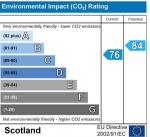
