The Property

Believed to date back to the mid 16th century, this distinctive period home is situated in the heart of Stratford upon Avon town centre and was formerly The Stag Inn, one of the few early pubs situated on the original town centre boundary. Converted into a residential dwelling in around 1901, this unique home has since served as a home, and in latter years a private railway museum housing an extensive collection of Railwayana. The property is now being offered with vacant possession, requires modernisation throughout and affords immense potential.

Entering, you are greeted by a central hallway with flagstone flooring, exposed beams and doorways off to the reception rooms. There is a pleasant lounge with hidden flagstone flooring, generous sitting room, dining / breakfast room and a large store / home office. The kitchen is accessed via the hallway, which sits adjacent to a ground floor bathroom. There is also a useful vaulted cellar, and rear stores attached.

To the first floor, a central landing provides access to four character filled bedrooms, complete with vaulted ceilings, exposed beams and in the main bedrooms, exposed floorboards.

Externally, there is a pleasant, enclosed courtyard garden, with a paved terrace, raised beds and various mature plants and shrubs throughout, providing a leafy backdrop. There is also a green house and gardeners WC.






Parking – There is no formal off street parking, but resident's permits are available via Warwick District Council at a cost of £25 per permit, per annum.

The Location

Stratford-upon-Avon is internationally famous as the birthplace of William Shakespeare and home to the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. It attracts almost four million visitors a year who come to see its rich variety of historic buildings. Stratford is also a prosperous riverside market town which provides South Warwickshire with a wide range of national and local stores, fine restaurants, a good choice of public and private schools and excellent sporting and recreational amenities. These include golf courses, swimming pool and leisure centre, race course, the nearby north Cotswold Hills as well as the River Avon for anglers and boating enthusiasts.

The town is well served by trunk road/motorway and rail communications with regular train services to Birmingham Moor Street and London Marylebone (via Warwick Parkway/Leamington Spa stations), whilst junction 15 of the M40 motorway is situated within about 15 minutes drive. Birmingham International Airport, the National Exhibition and Agricultural Centres and International Convention Centre are all located in under one hour's travel whilst other well known business centres including Warwick & Leamington Spa, Coventry, Evesham, Redditch and Solihull are all readily accessible.
